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EDUCATION MINISTRY ANNOUNCES \$10.7 MILLION FOR ADULT LITERACY IN ONTARIO

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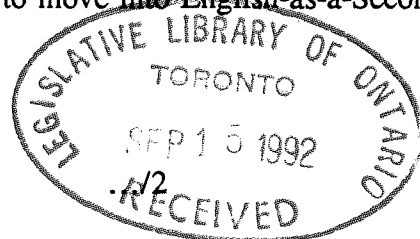
Ontario Minister of Education Tony Silipo today announced \$10.7 million in funding for 181 organizations that provide literacy programs and services for adults throughout the province.

The \$10.7 million includes an allocation of \$9.5 million to literacy organizations in four Ontario regions, and \$1.2 million to fund provincial organizations that provide special support services to literacy groups and practitioners.

"It is important that Ontarians have access to literacy services in their communities," said Mr. Silipo. "Through the support offered by the Ministry of Education community groups across the province help Ontarians obtain the literacy skills they need to play a full role in their communities."

Community groups and umbrella organizations that offer individual and group literacy training to adults, and services such as telephone hotlines, computer-based instruction, and drop-in centres will receive funding through the Ontario Community Literacy program.

A First Language Literacy program for immigrants who do not read and write in their own language will also receive funding. This initiative, provided by the Canadian Multicultural Literacy Centre in Toronto, acts as a bridge for immigrants to move into English-as-a-Second-Language programs.



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Funding will also be provided to projects designed to increase the literacy and basic skills of people on social assistance. These projects include literacy programs for single parent families in social housing.

Funds are also being used to provide literacy resource and learning materials through the literacy and language training/resource centre, Alpha Ontario. Other activities funded through this program include practitioner training activities and two electronic networks which link all English-and French-language literacy groups.

"This government recognizes the importance of literacy to individuals and communities," said Mr. Silipo. "It is vital that, during tough economic times, we continue to offer a wide range of flexible, creative literacy programs that are tailored to meet the needs of all Ontarians."
