Subject: **Malpractice Coverage Reimbursement – 2005 Coverage Year**

The automation of malpractice fee reimbursements for members of the Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA) was introduced for the 2001 coverage year. The reimbursement payment options available will remain the same for 2005.

If a Participation Form selecting Option A or Option B was completed, no further action is required for the 2005 coverage year. All future reimbursements will be automatically processed upon receipt of confirmation of payment from the CMPA. If you wish to change your payment option, please contact the ministry for a Reimbursement Participation Form to complete and return. A Payment Option Summary Sheet is attached for your reference. The following conditions must be met in order to select an automated payment option:

- § meet all eligibility requirements for reimbursement in the Ontario Reimbursement Program
- § be a member of the CMPA
- § be registered for direct bank deposit with the ministry
- § have completed the ministry Reimbursement Participation Form which includes the authorization for CMPA to transfer reimbursement related information

If you have selected Option C - Post Annual Reimbursement for the 2004 coverage year, a MOHLTC Application for Reimbursement will be sent to you along with your CMPA Acknowledgement of payment, early in 2005. It must be completed and received by the ministry no later than June 30, 2005 for payment. If you do not receive an application, please contact the ministry. Reimbursements for the 2005 coverage year under Option C will not be processed until 2006.

Malpractice Reimbursement Program Payment Options

Reimbursement Options	Description	Requirements
Option A Early Annual Reimbursement	- Physicians pay their Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA) annual fee in full by January 1st of the coverage year with a post-dated cheque dated May 1st or by authorizing annual direct debit. - Information related to malpractice fee payment is transmitted electronically to the ministry from CMPA. <u>The full reimbursement entitlement is paid in the current coverage year prior to the deposit of the physician's post-dated cheque or the direct debit.</u>	- Licensed with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and practice in Ontario during the coverage period - Classified as a practicing physician by the CMPA (Type of Work Code not 12, 13 or 14) - Registered with the ministry and CMPA for Option A - Registered with the ministry for direct bank deposit
Option B Quarterly Reimbursement	- Physicians pay their CMPA fees either monthly or annually. - Information related to malpractice fee payment is transmitted electronically to the ministry from CMPA. <u>Reimbursement entitlement is paid in 4 equal payments over the course of the coverage year.</u>	- Licensed with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and practice in Ontario during the coverage period - Registered with the ministry and CMPA for Option B - Registered with the ministry for direct bank deposit
Option C Regular Annual Reimbursement	- Physicians pay their fees/premiums either monthly or annually. - Applications for reimbursement are mailed to physicians in January <u>following</u> the coverage year. - A reimbursement application is completed and sent to the MOHLTC following the coverage year. <u>Reimbursement payment is made within 8 weeks of receipt of a completed application.</u>	- Licensed with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and practice in Ontario during the coverage period - Registered with the ministry and CMPA for Option C - Completed ministry application for reimbursement received by MOHLTC by June 30 following the coverage year. - Proof of malpractice fee/premium paid, i.e. CMPA Acknowledgement or receipt of premium paid if with another carrier

Once selected the reimbursement payment option shall remain in effect until such time as a signed authorization is received to cancel and/or modify the selection.
