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Re: Diskette Elimination

As previously communicated, diskettes will no longer be accepted for OHIP medical claims submission after **February 19, 2013**. Most providers were required to stop submitting claims by December 18th, January 18th or February 1st. If you have a diskette deadline of February 19th, your claims being submitted on diskette must be received by a Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC) Claims Processing Office on or before February 19, 2013.

If a diskette is received after February 19, 2013, it will not be processed.

After February 19th the ministry will no longer have the technical capability or staffing to process diskettes.

Extensions will not be granted under any circumstance.

The ministry has introduced a new Medical Claims Electronic Data Transfer (MC EDT) web page which allows manual upload and download of claim submission files using the internet. Please refer to [INFOBulletin #4568](#) on the ministry's website for information on the new service.

Claims can be submitted electronically via the legacy EDT system or MC EDT. If you are already registered with one of these services, please submit your claims via EDT or MC EDT. If you have not yet registered please do so as soon as possible to avoid payment issues.
