Clinical Traineeship: Funding is available through the CME Program, to assist eligible physicians to extend their continuing medical education by undertaking a Clinical Traineeship. A Clinical Traineeship is a learning experience of two weeks or longer, designed to meet the learning needs of a physician in knowledge areas pertinent to the physician's practice or community. The Clinical Traineeship uses the educational resources of a faculty, institution, hospital, and/or a community-based setting and involves a preceptor who is an individual, usually a physician, or an institution.

Visiting Speakers Program: The Visiting Speakers Program provides funding assistance to allow a physician in a community with a Rural Index of Ontario (RIO) 2008 score greater than or equal to 40 to organize in that community a continuing medical education event that addresses current medical issues or knowledge needs pertinent to the physician's practice, the community and allied healthcare providers in the community.
