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Re: Electronic Data Transfer Decommissioning

This is a reminder that the GONet/modem Electronic Data Transfer (EDT) service will not be available after March 31, 2015. The Medical Claims Electronic Data Transfer (MCEDT) service is the only approved channel for electronic submission of medical claims.

Claims submitted using the GONet/modem EDT service after March 26, 2015 will not be processed and must be resubmitted using MCEDT. If you have not received a Batch Edit Report by March 26th for claims submitted via EDT before that date you must resubmit using the MCEDT service. It is recommended that all claims be submitted using the MCEDT service effective immediately.

To access MCEDT you must set up a GOSecure account and enrol in MCEDT. Instructions on how to complete the registration/enrolment were sent to all GONet EDT users in January & February of 2014 and a follow up letter sent in October. To release the registration information, the ministry will require the secure code word you supplied when registering for the GONet/modem EDT service.
