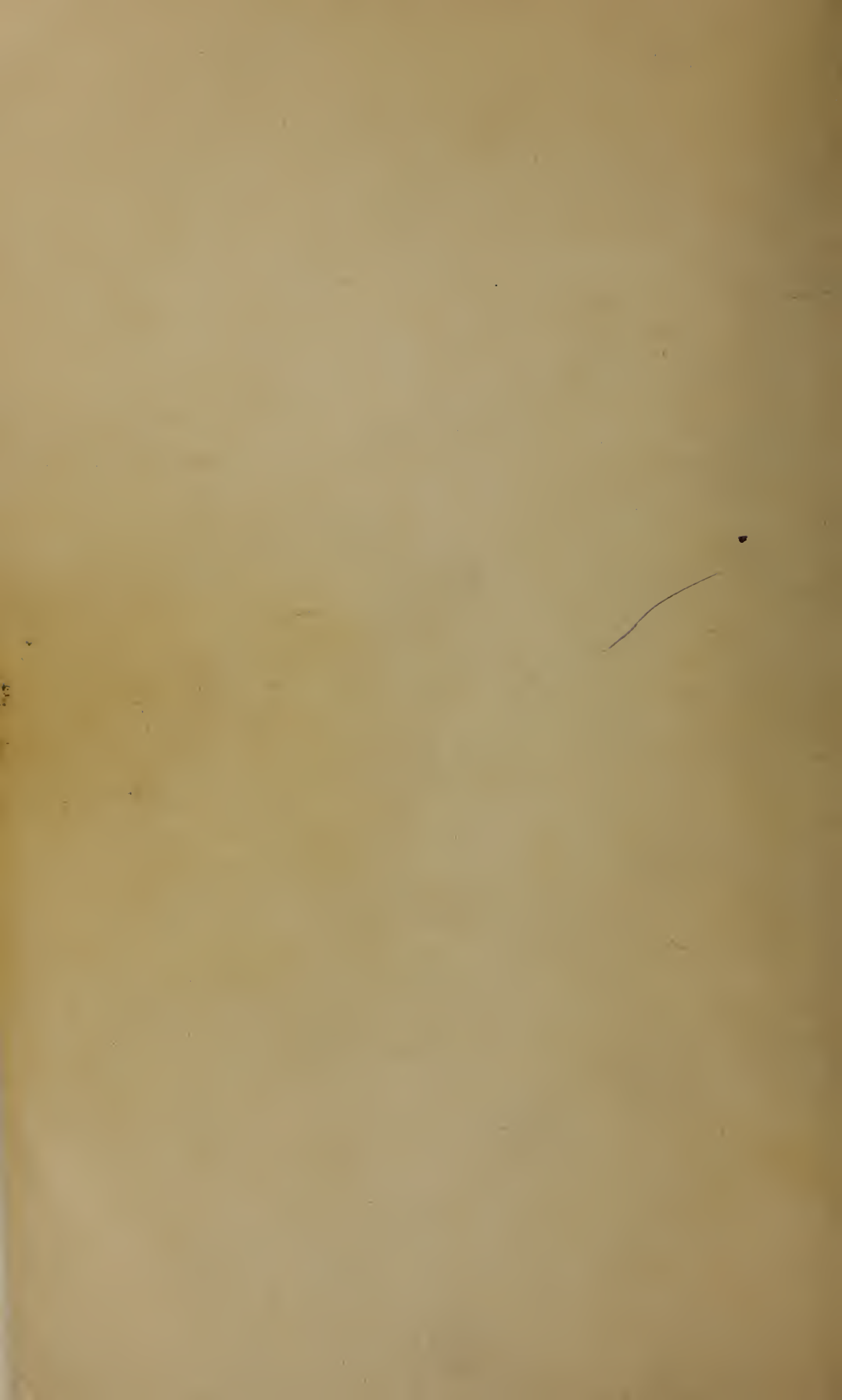

PREFACE

This volume is the third annual catalogue of Ontario Government publications. It is a cumulation of the monthly checklists for 1974. Some publications which were restricted in their distribution to the public, and which were therefore omitted from the monthly list, have been included in order that the bibliography might accurately reflect the total publication output of the various government ministries and agencies.

As the present bibliography is intended primarily for reference purposes, no attempt has been made to indicate the availability of particular publications or to include prices. Information regarding ordering procedures and price of publications is given in the monthly checklist, which is available free of charge from the Publications Service Section, Printing Services Branch, 3B7 Macdonald Block, Queen's Park, Toronto M7A 1N8.

Many publications listed in the annual catalogue are available for consultation at depository libraries for Ontario Government publications and a list of full depository libraries has been included to assist the user in locating them. The term "full depository" means that the library automatically receives all publications in the monthly checklist which are designated by a "D". There are also selective depository libraries throughout the province, which receive any "D" items they specifically request. These libraries have not been listed, as their collections would be less complete.

Maps, posters, press releases, speeches, and publications of an internal nature have not been included. Reprints of articles written by government officials and appearing in non-government publications have not been included, unless they have the imprint of a ministry.

A retrospective bibliography of Ontario Government publications for the years 1956-1971 is presently being completed in the Bibliographic Services Centre, Printing Services Branch, and will be published later this year. In 1976, the Ministry of Government Services will also publish a bibliography of Ontario Government publications from 1867-1900, compiled by Dr. Olga Bishop.

The annual catalogue was compiled by Kenneth E. Sundquist, Senior Catalogue Librarian, Bibliographic Services Centre, in consultation with Hazel I. MacTaggart.
