PREFACE

This volume is the eighth **Annual Catalogue** of Ontario Government publications. It is a cumulation of the **Monthly Checklist** for 1979. Some publications which were restricted in their distribution to the public and which were therefore omitted from the monthly list, have been included in order that the bibliography might accurately reflect the total publication output of the various government ministries and agencies.

Many publications listed in the annual catalogue are available for consultation at depository libraries for Ontario Government publications and a list of full depository libraries has been included to assist the user in locating them. The term "full depository" means that the library automatically receives all publications in the **Monthly Checklist** which are designated by a "D". There are also selective depository libraries throughout the province, which receive any "D" items they specifically request. These libraries have not been listed, as their collections would be less complete.

The material is arranged alphabetically under issuing body with annual reports listed first.

Publications that have been depository items during the year 1979, are marked with a "D" as in the **Monthly Checklist**. Also, the availability and price of all publications distributed by the Publications Service is indicated. On the other hand, no attempt has been made to indicate the availability or price of publications that may only be obtained from the issuing body.

Maps, posters, press releases, speeches, and publications of an internal nature have not been included. Reprints of articles written by government officials and appearing in non-government publications have not been included, unless they have the imprint of a ministry.

The annual catalogue was edited and compiled in the Checklist and Catalogue Service, Legislative Library, Research and Information Services by Mance G. Carbery, Manager, with the assistance of Eveline Marron, Catalogue Librarian and E. Pulver Zajfman, Administrative Clerk.

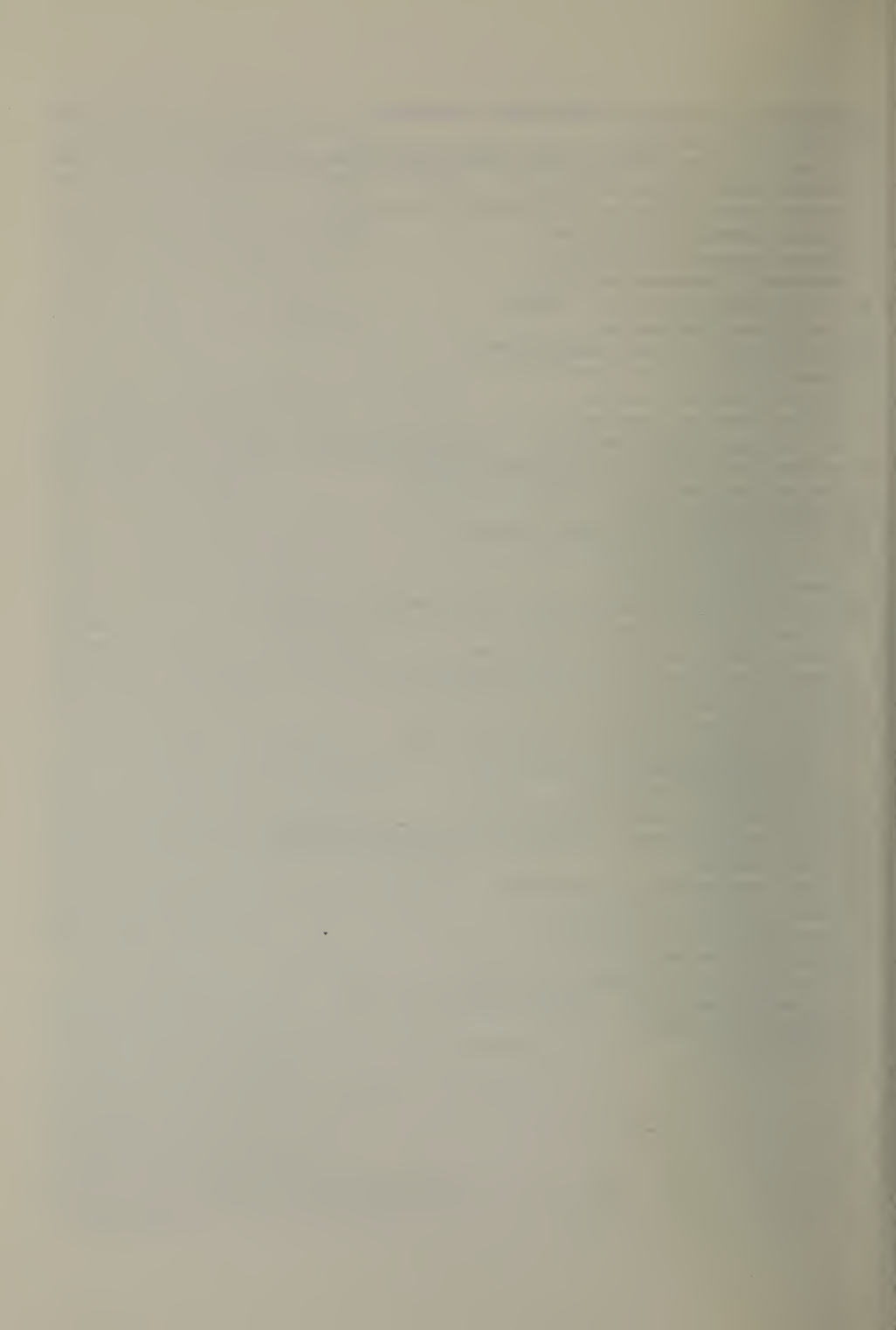
