Inspection Summary/Sommaire d'inspection		
The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Critical Incident inspection regarding the sexual abuse of 2 female residents by a personal support worker (PSW) student on July 22, 2010.. During the course of the inspection, the inspector spoke with: the Administrator, The Assistant Director of Care (ADOC), a nurse manager, and one registered staff. During the course of the inspection, the inspector: reviewed the health files of both residents, the home's policy regarding abuse, the social worker's notes of the post-interviews of both residents, and the administrator's notes of the home's investigation. The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

Non-compliance with requirements under the *Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007* (LTCHA) was found. (A requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.19 (1).

19(1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall protect residents from abuse by anyone and shall ensure that residents are not neglected by the licensee or staff.

Findings:

On July 22, 2010, a Personal Support Worker (PSW) student made sexual remarks to 2 female residents, about their bodies while in their respective showers and a physical gesture with a shower head to one of the residents. These words and actions were verified by a staff person witness and are considered a form of abuse.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg. 79/10, s.98

98 Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the appropriate police force is immediately notified of any alleged, suspected or witnessed incident of abuse or neglect of a resident that the licensee suspects may constitute a criminal offence.

Findings:

The Administrator reports that police were not notified by the home because their interview revealed that the student did not feel she was being inappropriate or abusive.
