WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 36. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that staff use safe transferring and positioning devices or techniques when assisting residents. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 36.

Findings/Faits saillants :

The licensee did not ensure that staff uses safe transferring and positioning devices when assisting residents

During transferring of resident from bed to chair, PSW who was assisting another PSW with the mechanical Hoyer lift, answered her cell phone while she was transferring the resident with the mechanical lift.

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that staff use safe transferring and positioning devices or techniques when assisting residents, to be implemented voluntarily.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 131. Administration of drugs

Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 131. (2) The licensee shall ensure that drugs are administered to residents in accordance with the directions for use specified by the prescriber. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 131 (2).

Findings/Faits saillants :

The registered staff did not ensure that drugs are administered to residents in accordance with the directions for use as specified by the prescriber.

There was a medication error in the administration of a topical patch. One Registered staff failed to remove the topical patch as ordered and another Registered staff applied two topical patch with the same date, consequently resident had three topical patches found on chest.

WN #3: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 135. Medication incidents and adverse drug reactions

Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 135. (2) In addition to the requirement under clause (1) (a), the licensee shall ensure that,**
(a) all medication incidents and adverse drug reactions are documented, reviewed and analyzed;
(b) corrective action is taken as necessary; and
(c) a written record is kept of everything required under clauses (a) and (b). O. Reg. 79/10, s. 135 (2).

Findings/Faits saillants :

Corrective action was not taken as necessary to address the medication error of the administration of a topical patch.
