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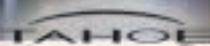

Canada and Ontario continue to work together on improving the health of the Great Lakes environment under an agreement first signed some 30 years ago. Under this agreement, we are working with more than 260 partners on over 160 projects to rehabilitate fish and wildlife and their habitats, protect and restore wetlands, educate the public about invasive species, protect species at risk and gain a better understanding of Great Lakes basin ecosystems.
