

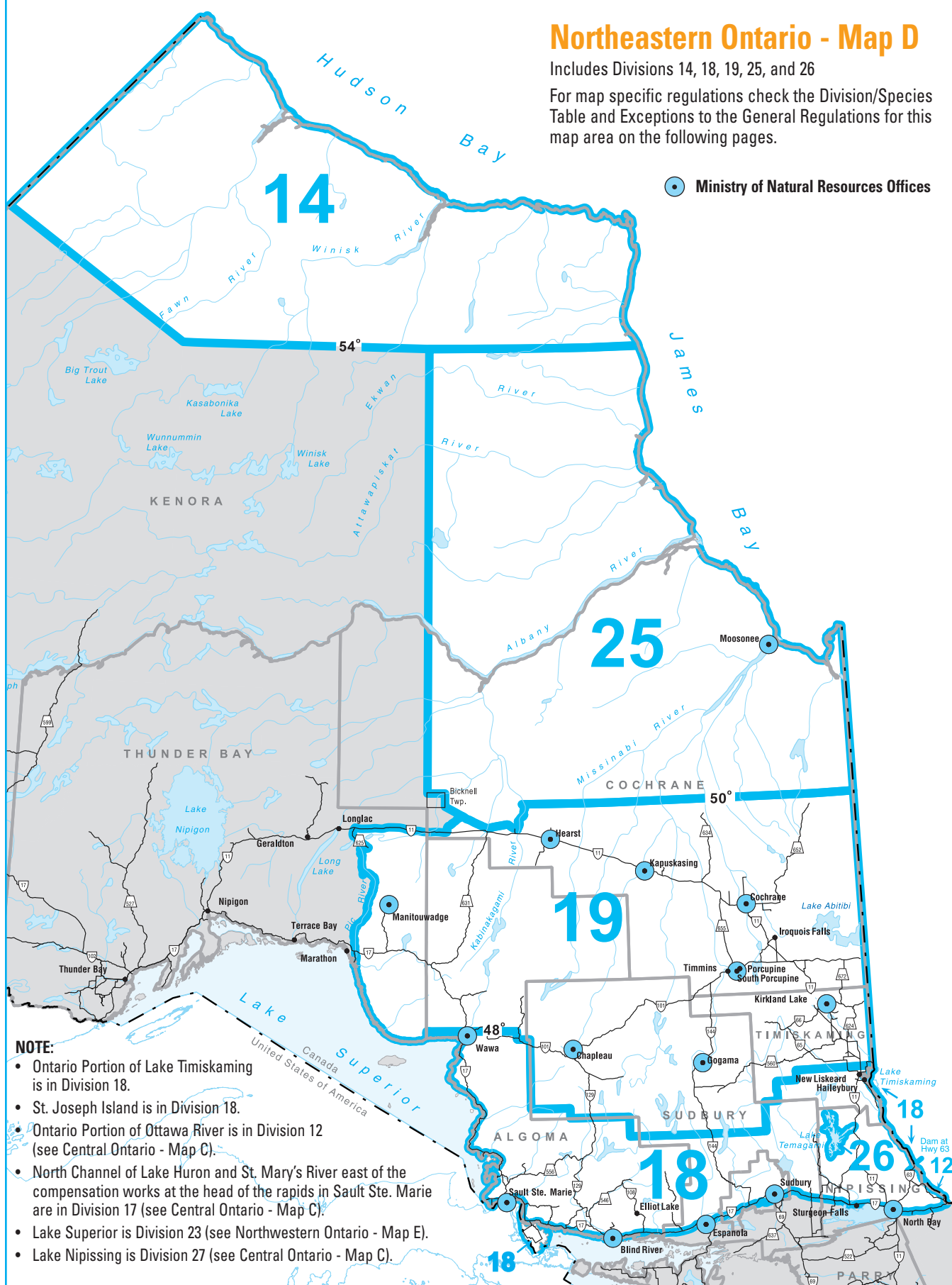
NORTHEASTERN ONTARIO – MAP D

Northeastern Ontario (Map D) Division/Species Table

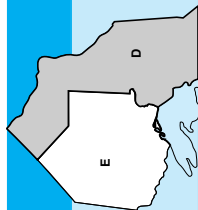

Size Limits

Unless otherwise stated, the length referred to is total length. (See page 4.)

Size restrictions listed above apply to both Sport Fishing and Conservation licences, except as stated otherwise.

Daily Catch and Possession Limits

Daily catch and possession limits will depend on the type of fishing licence you hold, the species and where they are caught and in some cases the size of the fish.

The **catch** limit is the number of fish you are allowed to catch and keep in one day. The **possession** limit is the number you are allowed to have in your possession on hand, in cold storage, in transit, etc. Possession limits are the same as one day's catch limit except where otherwise specified.

Shore Meals - Fish caught that day and eaten are counted as part of your daily catch limit.

Northeastern Ontario

General Notes

- All tributaries to Lake Superior in Div. 18 & 19, rainbow trout catch and possession limit of two (2), Conservation licence limit of one (1).

Licences for Provincial Border Waters

Ontario-Quebec Border: You may fish in Lake Timiskaming and throughout Div. 12 (Ottawa River) and in Div. 12A (Lake St. Francis) with either an Ontario Resident or a Quebec Resident fishing licence.

Bait and Gear Restrictions

- In Division 14 recreational fishers are permitted to possess and use only single-pointed barbless hooks. A line may only have one single-pointed barbless hook attached to it.
- Live fish may not be used for bait or possessed for use as bait in:
 - Div. 14;
 - Certain waters in the territorial districts of Algoma, Cochrane, Nipissing, Sudbury and Timiskaming.
 - Check with the local MNR office for specific waters. See "Exceptions to the General Regulations."
- In Lake Temagami (Div. 26) no person may use as bait or possess for use as bait any sucker, smelt or whitefish, including lake herring (cisco).

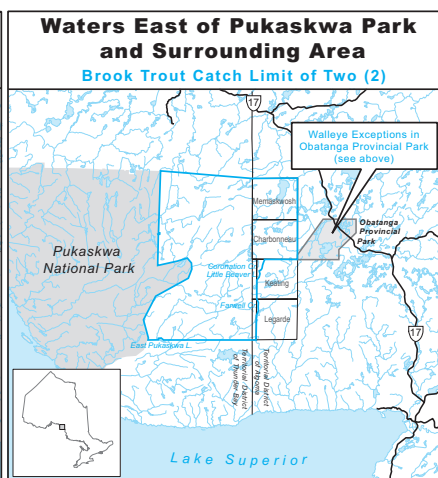
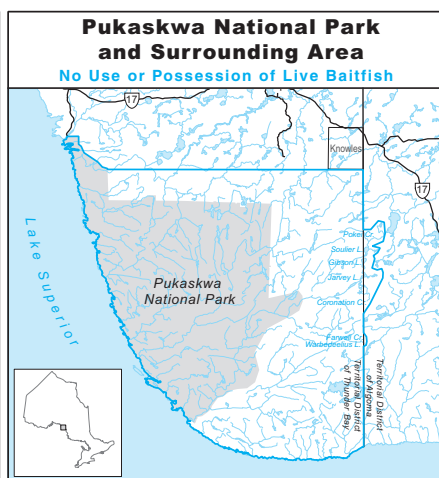

Safe Boating and Fishing

Safe Boating in Areas of Commercial Fishing

The commercial fishing industry in Ontario, which is primarily focused on the Great Lakes, harvests fish by using trawls and a variety of stationary nets. All nets must be identified by means of buoys, stakes and markers which identify the owner of the net and the location of the beginning or end of the net. Besides these markers, there may be additional buoys (e.g. plastic or steel cans) that indicate intermediate portions of the net or anchor lines. Boaters should be aware that, because the length of some nets may exceed several thousand meters, it may not be possible to see both ends.

To ensure safe boating in areas where commercial fishing activity takes place, please consider the following:

- Many retail and wholesale freshwater fish outlets can provide information regarding local net marking systems
- Many local yacht clubs, sailing clubs, power squadrons and marinas have information regarding commercial fishing activities in local waters. In some cases, detailed maps of fishing locations and specific markings may be available
- Report unmarked nets immediately to the closest Ministry of Natural Resources office
- Treat commercial fishing gear with the same caution as any other floating device, apparatus or debris
- When a net marker is encountered it may not always be possible to observe which way the net runs under the water especially during summer months, when nets are usually set in cooler deeper water
- Lures and other sharp foreign objects stuck in commercial nets are hazards to commercial fishers
- Tampering with commercial fishing gear is dangerous to boaters and is an offence under the Fisheries Act

- If your gear accidentally becomes entangled in a commercial net, contact the commercial operator immediately
- Entanglement of cannonballs may present a serious and dangerous situation to boaters. Cannonball cables, if not released from the net immediately, can act like an anchor. If this occurs, the downrigger line should be cut immediately with wire cutters
- Boaters should recognize that maneuvering a trawler can be very difficult. Be aware that standard boating rules and regulations apply when encountering any large commercial fishing vessel.

Safe Boating and Fishing Near Hydro-electrical Generating Stations and Dams

These areas can be dangerous. Boaters and anglers should avoid getting too close to the powerful surge of water from dams and spillways.

To ensure safe boating and fishing in these areas, please:

- Approach slowly and always wear a personal flotation device
- Watch for warning signs or barriers above or below dams and stay a safe distance away from them
- Stay clear of the headpond or tailrace water at dams and spillways. Water level and flow can change without warning. It can quickly swamp your boat and put you in the grip of an undertow
- Don't wade into moving water
- Stay sober. Drinking and driving a power vessel is just as dangerous and illegal as drinking and driving a car.

ATTENTION MUSKELLUNGE ANGLERS



Muskellunge are highly prized by many anglers and Ontario offers some of the finest angling opportunities in the world. It is important that management actions be taken to ensure Ontario's muskellunge are sustained in the future. Anglers are encouraged to help with the following project.

The Cleithrum Project – The Cleithrum Project is the provincial repository for biological data on muskellunge and northern pike. The cleithrum (a crescent shaped bone under the gill flap) should be removed from any fish found dead or which has been angled and is being kept for food or mounting. Information on the size of the fish, such as length, weight and girth, and the body of water where the fish was obtained should be recorded and submitted along with the cleithrum bone(s) to Lake Ontario Research Unit, Glenora Fisheries Station, Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources, RR #4, Picton ON, K0L 2T0.

Anglers – Are You Moving Firewood?



Emerald Ash Borer

To date it is estimated that over 10 million ash trees are dead or dying in the United States and Canada due to Emerald Ash Borer infestation. In Essex County over 100,000 ash trees have been removed to help control the spread of Emerald Ash Borer. Another 15,000 maple and other species of trees were removed in the Toronto area to help control the spread of Asian Longhorned Beetle.

Anglers, you can help prevent the spread of invasive insects to forested areas by contacting your local Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) office **prior to moving any firewood**. Firewood may contain insect and plant diseases that could easily spread to other forest locations if you move firewood from your home to your campsite.

The best way to protect your forest is to use local firewood from the area where you are fishing.

The CFIA strictly controls the movement of firewood from pest-regulated areas of Canada. As a result, **at the time of printing of this information, the CFIA has placed all of Essex County and parts of Chatham-Kent under quarantine to control the spread of Emerald Ash Borer. Firewood from anywhere in the United States is not permitted entry into Canada without a permit from the CFIA.**
