Community-Based Nomination Process for LHIN Boards Slated to Begin September 26

In June 2005, the government appointed 14 founding Local Health Integration Network (LHIN) board chairs and 28 founding board directors. The goal is to have a full complement of 9 members for each LHIN by the end of 2005. The LHIN founding board members are working on a community-based nomination process to identify and recommend an additional three board candidates per LHIN to the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care. In order to generate awareness of the process in communities across Ontario, LHIN board chairs will be hosting Public Information Sessions, which will be advertised in newspapers the week of September 19. The sessions will:

- Provide information about LHINs
- Explain the board selection process to the community and answer questions
- Provide board members with an opportunity to meet people within their LHIN
