

Weekly Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three

Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.
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This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending July 25, 2005

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline increased by 1.0 cents to 91.1 cents a litre as higher prices in Toronto and London more than offset lower prices elsewhere.

Prices rose by 3.5 cents in London, 2.3 cents in Toronto West, and 1.9 cents in Toronto East. Prices fell by 3.4 cents in Sault Ste. Marie, 3.3 cents in Sudbury, 3.0 cents in Thunder Bay, 2.4 cents in Windsor, 1.0 cents in North Bay, and less than a cent in Ottawa and Timmins. The average price gap between southern and northern Ontario narrowed from a two-month high of 7.6 cents to 3.6 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after increasing three straight weeks, declined by 0.9 cents from a record high to 90.2 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 1.0 cents to 94.0 cents. Prices rose by 3.1 cents in Toronto, 1.2 cents in Montreal, and less than a cent in Winnipeg (to a record high of 94.1 cents) and Edmonton (to a record high of 89.0 cents). Prices fell by 2.1 cents in Vancouver, 1.1 cents in Regina, and less than a cent in Quebec City, Calgary, and Halifax. The Canadian average retail diesel price, after increasing two straight weeks, declined by 0.7 cents from a record high to 92.6 cents.

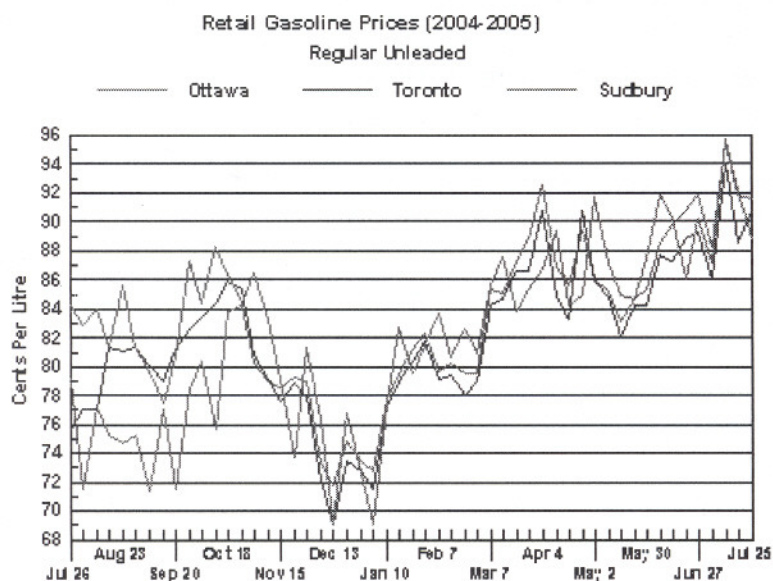
