

Weekly Gasoline Report



The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three

Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

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This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending November 28, 2005

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 0.6 cents to 85.7 cents a litre, a six-month low, reflecting lower wholesale prices and price wars in some markets.

Prices fell by 2.6 cents in Windsor (to a six-month low) and Thunder Bay, 1.9 cents in Timmins (to a five-month low), 1.7 cents in London (to a nine-month low) and North Bay (to a six-month low), and less than a cent in Ottawa (to a six-month low), Toronto West (to a five-month low), and Toronto East (to a six-month low). Prices rose by 4.7 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (from a ten-month low) and 3.9 cents in Sudbury (from a four-month low). Windsor was the lowest-priced market for the sixth straight week. Prices in southern Ontario averaged 85.1 cents and in the north they averaged 90.9 cents, a difference of 5.8 cents, up from 4.4 cents the week before. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the eighth straight week, by 2.1 cents to 91.7 cents, a four-month low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 1.9 cents to 86.4 cents, a nine-month low. Prices fell by 5.7 cents in Montreal (to a nine-month low), 3.3 cents in Winnipeg (to a nine-month low), 2.7 cents in Edmonton (to an eleven-month low), 2.6 cents in Vancouver (to a nine-month low), 1.8 cents in Halifax (to a six-month low), 1.5 cents in Calgary (to a nine-month low), and 1.0 cents in Toronto (to a six-month low). Prices rose by 5.0 cents in Regina and 4.0 cents in Saint John, both from nine-month lows. The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the fifth straight week, by 2.0 cents to 97.7 cents, a three-month low.

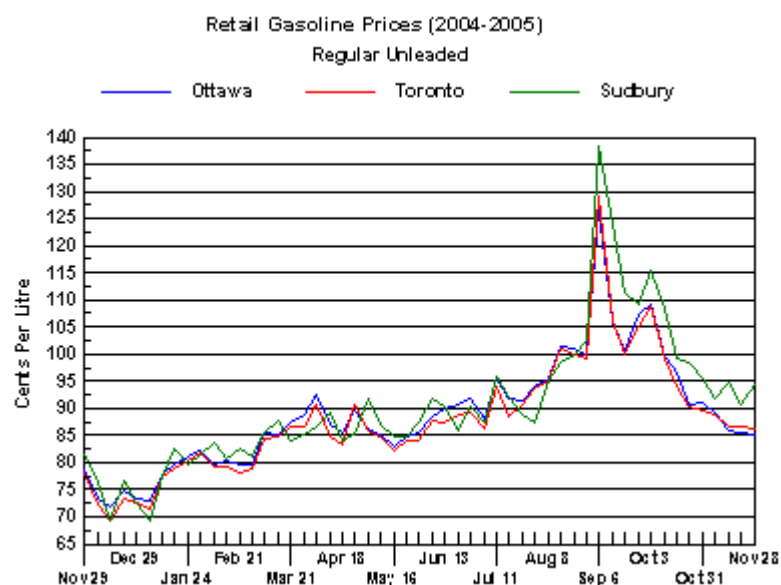
