

Weekly Gasoline Report



The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three

Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

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This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending December 12, 2005

Despite higher wholesale prices, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 1.3 cents from a five-week high to 88.6 cents a litre.

Prices fell by 3.7 cents in Windsor (from a two-month high), 2.3 cents in Toronto West (from a two-month high), 2.1 cents in Toronto East (from a two-month high), 1.1 cents in Ottawa, and 0.1 cents in Sudbury. Prices rose by 11.0 cents from a nine-month low in North Bay (to a six-week high), 5.2 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to a two-month high), 1.1 cents in London (to a five-week high), and 0.8 cents in Thunder Bay (from a six-month low). Prices in southern Ontario averaged 88.2 cents and in the north they averaged 91.4 cents, a difference of 3.2 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the tenth straight week, by 0.1 cents to 90.7 cents, a four-month low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 0.5 cents from a four-week high to 89.6 cents. Prices fell by 5.8 cents in Montreal, 2.5 cents in Edmonton, 1.0 cents in Halifax (from a two-month high), and 0.1 cents in Vancouver (to a ten-month low). Prices rose by 6.0 cents in Saint John and Quebec City (both to six-week highs), 4.1 cents in Regina, 1.0 cents in Toronto (to a two-month high), and 0.1 cents in Winnipeg. The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the seventh straight week, by 1.1 cents to 95.1 cents, a four-month low.

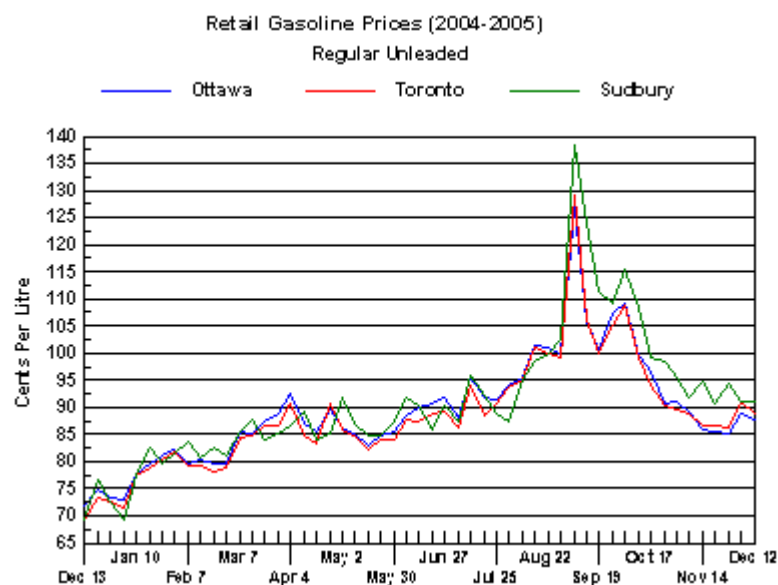
