

Weekly Gasoline Report



The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three

Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

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This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending January 23, 2006

Higher prices in Toronto, Ottawa, and London offset lower prices elsewhere, causing the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to increase by 1.9 cents to 94.9 cents a litre.

Prices rose by 3.2 cents in Toronto, 2.8 cents in London, and 2.2 cents in Ottawa. Prices fell by 7.8 cents in Thunder Bay (from a three-month high), 4.3 cents in Windsor, 2.4 cents in North Bay (from a three-month high), 2.1 cents in Sault Ste. Marie, 1.1 cents in Timmins, and 1.0 cents in Sudbury. The average price gap between southern and northern Ontario narrowed to 2.8 cents from a three-month high of 7.1 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the second straight week, by 1.0 cents to 92.3 cents, a five-week low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 0.2 cents to 93.9 cents. Prices rose by 1.2 cents in Toronto and 0.7 cents in Vancouver, but fell by 1.3 cents in Winnipeg (to a six-week low), 1.1 cents in Edmonton, 1.0 cents in Regina (from a three-month high), and less than a cent in Saint John, Charlottetown (from a three-month high), and Montreal. The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the second straight week, by 1.0 cents to 94.9 cents, a five-month low.

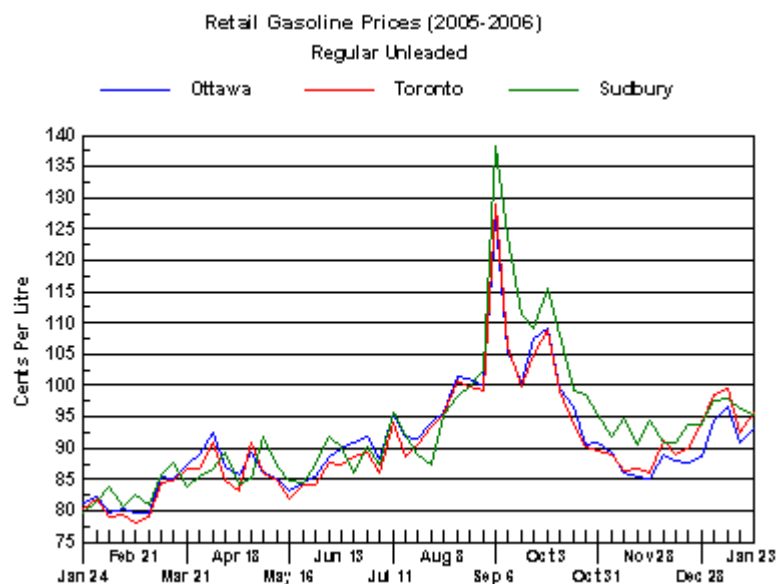
