

Weekly Gasoline Report



The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three

Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

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This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending January 30, 2006

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 2.8 cents to 92.1 cents a litre, a six-week low, reflecting lower wholesale prices and price wars in some markets.

Prices fell by 3.3 cents in Toronto (to a six-week low), 3.0 cents in North Bay (to a seven-week low), 2.9 cents in Ottawa and Timmins, 2.6 cents in London, 2.4 cents in Thunder Bay, 1.8 cents in Sudbury (to a six-week low), and 1.0 cents in Sault Ste. Marie. Prices rose by 1.3 cents in Windsor. The average price gap between southern and northern Ontario narrowed from 2.8 cents to 2.1 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after declining two straight weeks, was unchanged at 92.3 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 0.5 cents to 93.4 cents, a five-week low. Prices fell by 2.9 cents in Vancouver, 2.5 cents in Regina, 2.1 cents in Quebec City, 2.0 cents in Halifax and Saint John, 1.8 cents in Winnipeg (to a seven-week low), and 1.1 cents in Toronto. Prices rose by 2.4 cents in Montreal. The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the third straight week, by 0.3 cents to 94.6 cents, a five-month low.

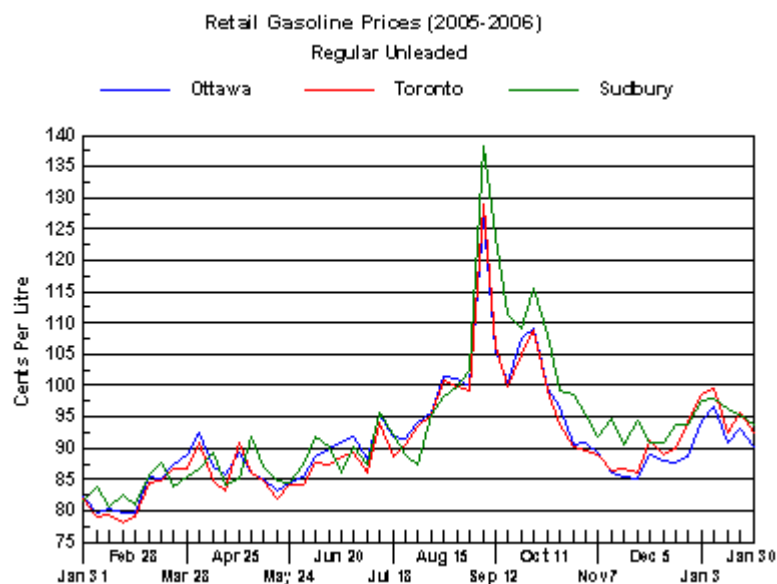
