

Weekly Gasoline Report



The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three

Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

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This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending March 13, 2006

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline increased for the fourth straight week, by 0.1 cents to 91.0 cents a litre, a six-week high, as lower prices in Toronto offset higher prices in other markets.

Prices rose by 5.0 cents in Thunder Bay (to a two-month high), 4.8 cents in Sault Ste. Marie, 3.0 cents in Timmins, 2.7 cents in London, 2.3 cents in Sudbury, 1.8 cents in North Bay, and 0.9 cents in Windsor. Prices fell by 0.9 cents in Toronto. The average price gap between southern and northern Ontario widened from 0.5 cents to 4.4 cents, a four-week high. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the third straight week, by 0.5 cents to 91.1 cents, a five-week high.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased for the fourth straight week, by 4.0 cents to 95.3 cents, a two-month high. Prices rose by 9.0 cents in Regina (to a four-month high), 6.0 cents in Montreal (to a two-month high), 5.2 cents in Winnipeg (to a five-month high), 4.2 cents in Toronto, 3.0 cents in Vancouver (to a five-month high), 1.8 cents in Saint John (to a two-month high), and less than a cent in Calgary and Edmonton (both to five-month highs). Prices fell by 0.1 cents in Quebec City. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the third straight week, by 1.4 cents to 94.2 cents, a six-week high.

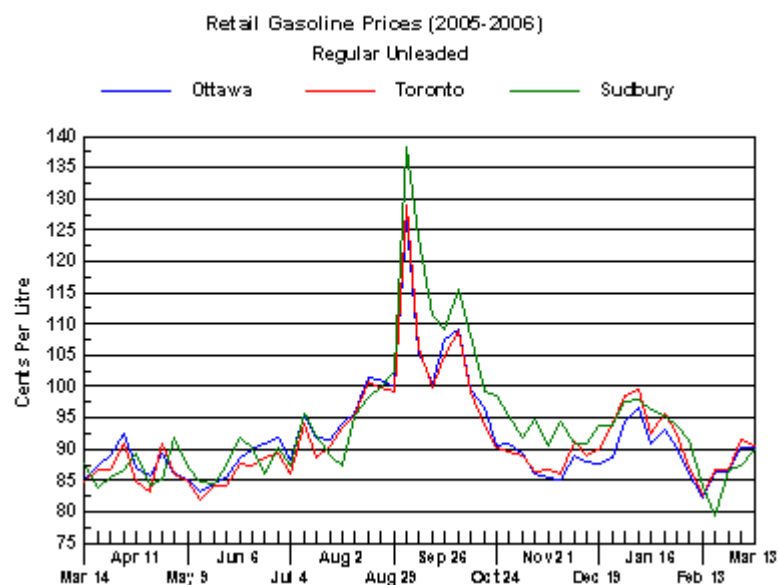
