This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending June 5, 2006

Higher wholesale prices caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to increase for the second straight week, by 1.4 cents to 102.5 cents a litre, a six-week high.

Prices rose by 3.4 cents in London (to a six-week high), 2.9 cents in Ottawa (to a six-week high), 1.6 cents in North Bay, and 1.4 cents in Toronto (to a six-week high). Prices fell by 8.4 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to a three-month low), 1.0 cents in Windsor and Thunder Bay (the latter from a five-week high), and 0.9 cents in Sudbury. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed for the second straight week, from 6.0 cents to 2.3 cents, a two-month low. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined by 0.2 cents to 99.7 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased for the second straight week, by 2.1 cents to 108.3 cents, a six-week high. Prices rose by 7.1 cents from a two-month low in Halifax (to a five-week high), 5.0 cents in Quebec City (from a two-month low), 3.6 cents from a two-month low in Saint John (to a four-week high), 3.5 cents in Toronto (to a six-week high), and 2.9 cents in Montreal (to a six-week high). Prices fell by 3.4 cents in Charlottetown (to a two-month low), 1.4 cents in Vancouver (to a four-week low), and 0.3 cents in Calgary (to a two-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price, after increasing two straight weeks, declined by 0.2 cents from a four-week high to 102.2 cents.

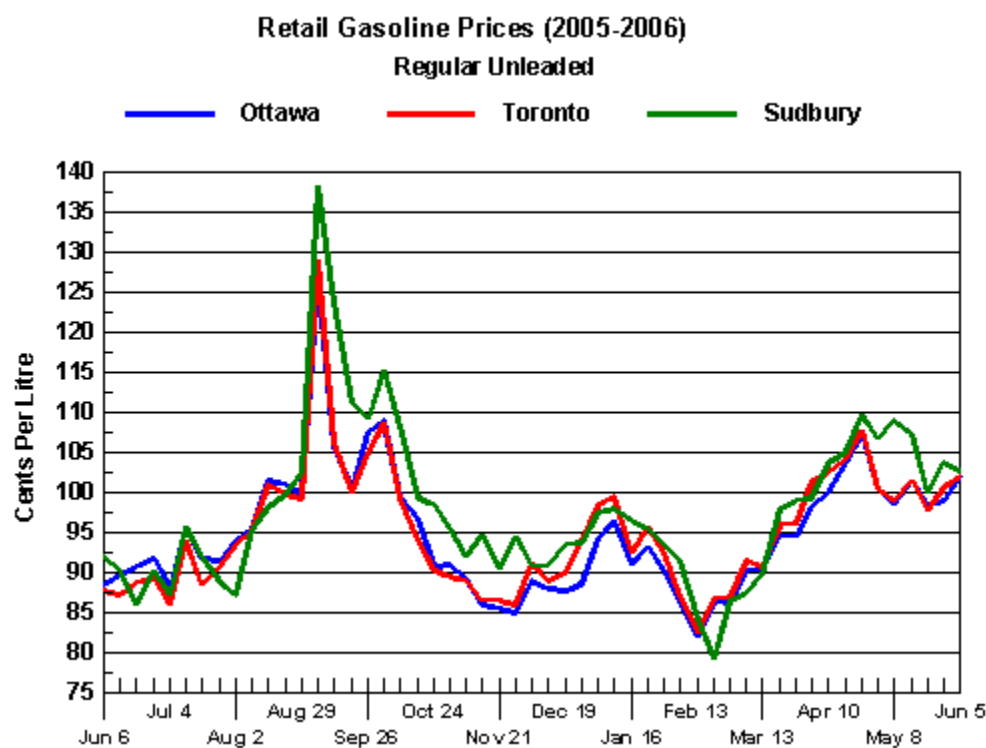
