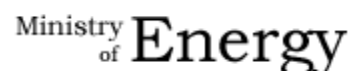


Weekly Gasoline Report



The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending July 10, 2006

Despite lower wholesale prices, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline increased for the third straight week, by 0.2 cents to 106.5 cents a litre, a three-month high.

Prices rose by 3.3 cents in Sudbury (to a two-month high), 2.0 cents in North Bay (to a two-month high), 1.7 cents in London (to a three-month high) and Sault Ste. Marie (to a nine-month high), and 0.3 cents in Toronto (to a three-month high). Prices fell by 3.2 cents in Windsor and less than a cent in Ottawa (from a two-month high) and Thunder Bay (from a ten-month high). The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened for the second straight week, from 4.2 cents to 5.5 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after declining two straight weeks, increased by 0.1 cents from a three-month low to 98.9 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased for the third straight week, by 1.3 cents to 109.6 cents, a three-month high. Prices rose by 10.0 cents in Quebec City (to a two-month high), 6.6 cents from a three-month low in Regina (to a two-month high), 5.2 cents in Montreal (to a three-month high), 3.1 cents in Edmonton and Calgary (both to a ten-month high), and 1.1 cents in Vancouver (to a five-week high). Prices fell by 1.4 cents in Toronto (from a nine-month high) and 0.3 cents in Halifax (from a four-week high). The Canadian average retail diesel price, after declining two straight weeks, increased by 0.1 cents from a three-month low to 101.4 cents.

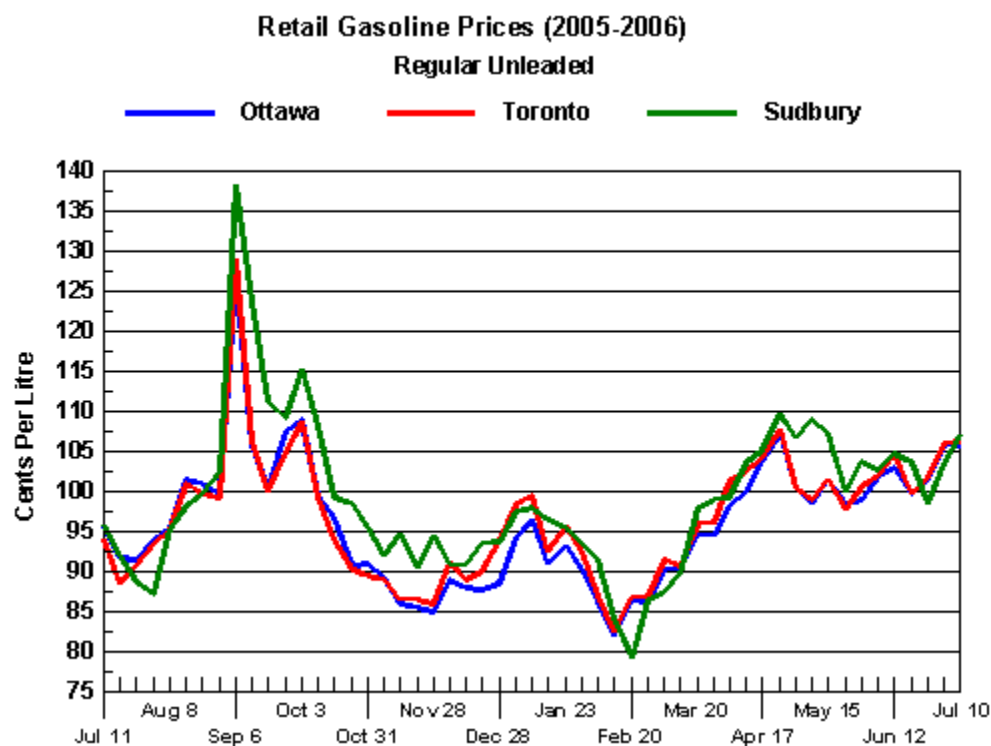
