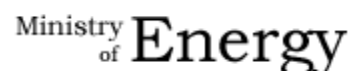


Weekly Gasoline Report



The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending July 24, 2006

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline, after increasing four straight weeks, declined by 1.1 cents from a nine-month high to 108.0 cents a litre, reflecting lower wholesale prices and price wars in some markets.

Prices fell by 4.9 cents from a three-month high in Windsor (to a four-week low), 1.6 cents in Toronto (from a ten-month high), 1.2 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (from a nine-month high), and 0.4 cents in Ottawa (from a ten-month high). Prices rose by 2.4 cents in Thunder Bay (to a ten-month high), 1.5 cents in North Bay (to a nine-month high), and 0.9 cents in Sudbury (to a ten-month high). Windsor had the lowest average price for the third straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened from 4.0 cents to 6.3 cents, a five-week high. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after increasing two straight weeks, declined by 1.2 cents from a four-week high to 98.5 cents, a three-month low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased for the fifth straight week, by 2.2 cents to 112.8 cents, an eleven-month high. Prices rose by 6.7 cents in Montreal (to an eleven-month high), 2.0 cents in Winnipeg (to an eleven-month high), 1.5 cents in Vancouver (to a two-month high), 1.4 cents in Toronto (to an eleven-month high), and 0.3 cents in Calgary. Prices fell by 0.4 cents in Edmonton. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the third straight week, by 0.5 cents to 102.4 cents, a four-week high.

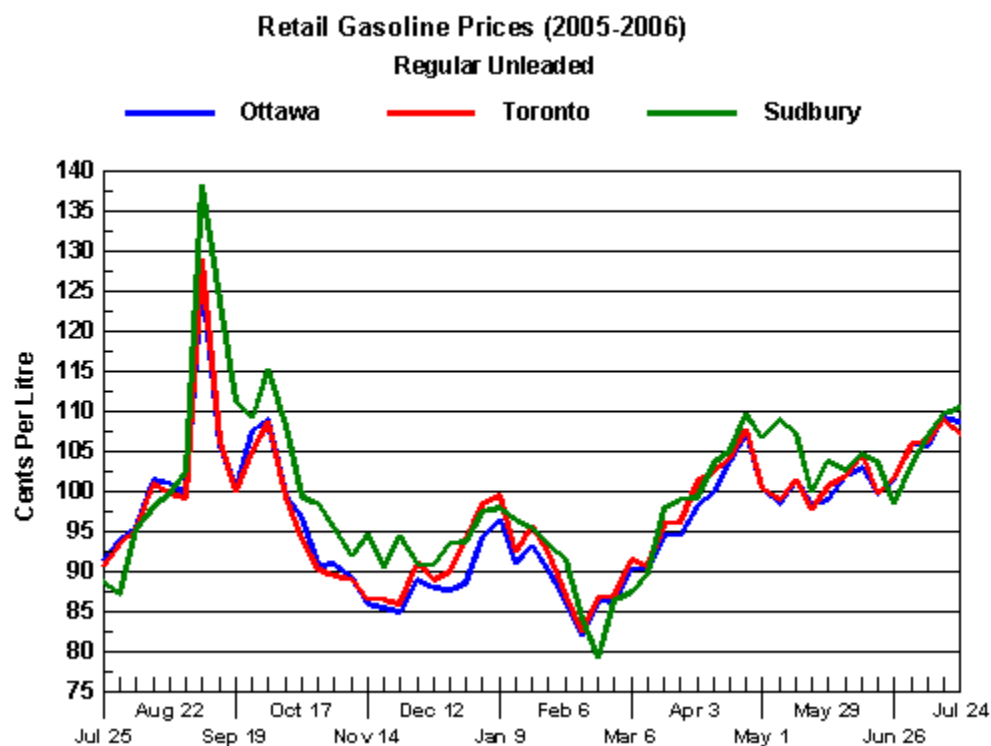
