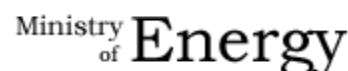


Weekly Gasoline Report



The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending October 10, 2006

Price wars in some markets caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to decline by 1.2 cents to 84.9 cents a litre.

Prices fell by 2.1 cents in Toronto East (from a four-week high), 1.6 cents in Toronto West (from a four-week high), 1.2 cents in Windsor (to an eight-month low), 1.0 cents in Timmins (to a seven-month low), and less than a cent in Ottawa and London. Prices rose by 6.1 cents in Sault Ste. Marie, 3.0 cents in North Bay (from a 20-month low), and 2.3 cents in Sudbury (from a seven-month low). Windsor had the lowest average price for the third straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened to 4.9 cents from a seven-month low of 1.3 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after declining eight straight weeks, increased by 0.7 cents from a 16-month low to 88.9 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 0.8 cents to 87.4 cents, an eight-month low. Prices fell by 3.0 cents in Saint John (to a 20-month low), 2.8 cents in Vancouver (to a seven-month low), 1.7 cents in Toronto (from a four-week high), 1.5 cents in Edmonton (to an eight-month low), and less than a cent in Winnipeg (to a seven-month low) and Halifax (to an eight-month low). Prices rose by 1.4 cents in Montreal and 0.3 cents in Quebec City, both from 19-month lows. The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the eighth straight week, by 0.1 cents to 90.0 cents, a 16-month low.

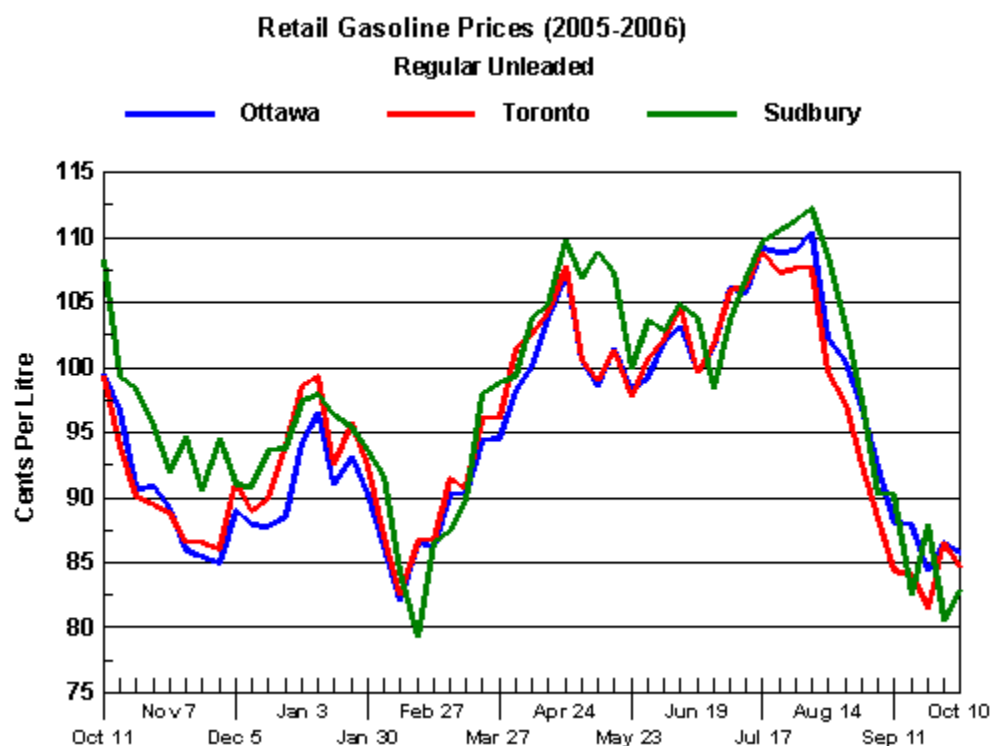
