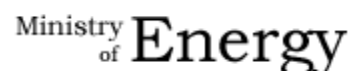


Weekly Gasoline Report



The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending October 30, 2006

Price changes were minimal this week, as the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline increased by 0.2 cents to 84.8 cents a litre.

Prices rose by 1.1 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to a two-month high) and less than a cent in Toronto East (to a four-week high), Ottawa, and London. Prices fell by less than a cent in Sudbury and Windsor. Windsor had the lowest average price for the sixth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario, after widening three straight weeks, was unchanged at a four-week high of 6.0 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined by 0.1 cents to 88.7 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 0.9 cents to 86.8 cents, an eight-month low. Prices fell by 2.4 cents in Regina (to an eight-month low), 1.8 cents in Toronto (to a 20-month low), 1.0 cents in Edmonton (to an 11-month low), and less than a cent in Quebec City (to a 20-month low), Calgary (to an 11-month low), Vancouver (to an eight-month low), and Montreal (from a five-week high). The Canadian average retail diesel price was unchanged at a four-week high of 90.2 cents.

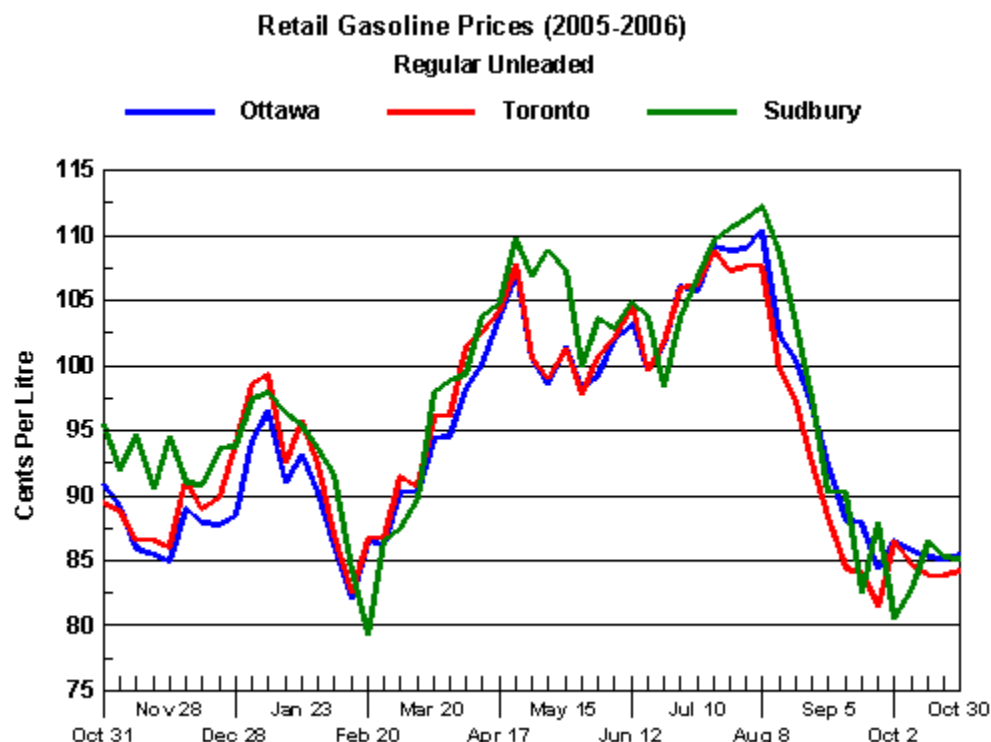
