

Weekly Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending July 23, 2006

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined for the second straight week, by 3.3 cents to 100.3 cents a litre, a four-month low, reflecting lower wholesale prices and price wars in some markets.

Prices fell by 8.2 cents in Thunder Bay (to a three-month low), 6.0 cents in Windsor (to a four-week low), 3.3 cents in Ottawa (to a four-month low), 3.2 cents in Toronto and London (both to a five-month low), 1.2 cents in Timmins, 1.0 cents in Sault Ste. Marie, and less than a cent in Sudbury and North Bay. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened from 9.6 cents to 10.1 cents, a six-month high. The Ontario average retail diesel price was unchanged at 94.5 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the second straight week, by 2.6 cents to 103.9 cents, a four-month low. Prices fell by 4.5 cents in Regina (from a two-month high), 4.4 cents in Winnipeg (from a six-week high), 4.2 cents in Vancouver (to a five-month low), 4.1 cents in Montreal, 3.7 cents in Calgary (from a two-month high), 3.7 cents from a six-week high in Saint John (to a five-week low), 3.5 cents from a two-month high in Halifax (to a five-week low), 2.0 cents in both Edmonton (from a two-month high) and Quebec City (to a four-week low), and less than a cent in St. Johns and Toronto (the latter to a five-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the second straight week, by 0.1 cents to 97.7 cents, a four-week low.

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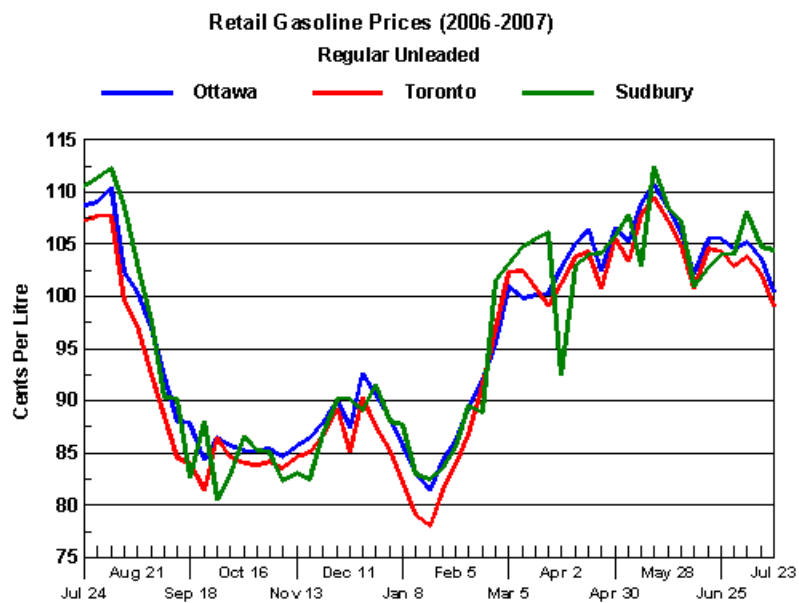
