

Weekly Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending January 14, 2008

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline, after increasing two straight weeks, declined by 2.9 cents from a six-week high to 102.7 cents a litre, reflecting lower wholesale prices and price wars in some markets.

Prices fell by 4.1 cents in Windsor (from a seven-month high), 4.0 cents in North Bay (from a six-week high), 3.7 cents in Sudbury (from a six-month high), 2.9 cents from a six-week high in Toronto (to a five-week low), 2.9 cents from a seven-month high in Ottawa (to a five-week low), 2.7 cents in London (from a six-week high), 2.5 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (from a seven-month high), and 1.0 cents in Timmins. Prices rose by 0.8 cents in Thunder Bay (to a two-month high). The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened for the second straight week, from 5.7 cents to 6.9 cents, a six-week high. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the second straight week, by 0.9 cents to 110.5 cents, a record high.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after increasing four straight weeks, declined by 1.8 cents from a six-week high to 105.8 cents. Prices fell by 6.9 cents in Montreal (to a two-month low), 1.7 cents in Vancouver (to a six-week low), and 0.2 cents in both Calgary (from a four-month high) and Toronto. Prices rose by 6.1 cents from a two-month low in Quebec City (to an eight-month high) and 1.3 cents in Saint John (to a seven-month high). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the third straight week, by 0.7 cents to 113.2 cents, a five-week low.

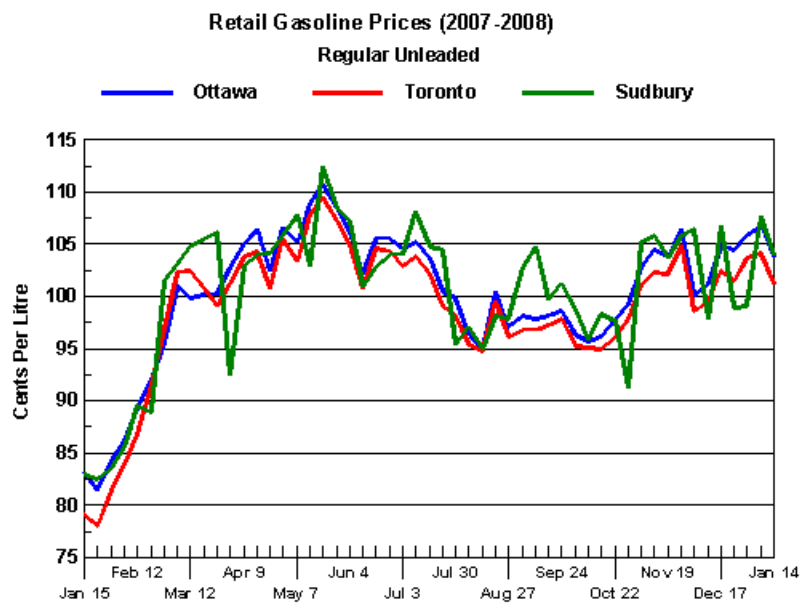
