

Weekly Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending June 16, 2008

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline increased for the fourth straight week, by 0.3 cents to 134.4 cents a litre, a record high, reflecting higher prices in northern Ontario.

Prices rose by 9.1 cents in North Bay (to a 33-month high), 9.0 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to a record 141.5 cents), 8.3 cents in Sudbury (to a 33-month high), 6.7 cents in Thunder Bay (to a record 140.4 cents), 4.0 cents in Timmins (to a record 141.9 cents), and 3.6 cents in Windsor (to a 33-month high). Prices fell by less than a cent in Ottawa, Toronto, and London, all from a record high. Windsor had the lowest average price for the third straight week. Prices in southern Ontario averaged 133.8 cents, 5.6 cents lower than in northern Ontario; last week, prices in the south were higher than in the north. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after declining two straight weeks, increased by 4.9 cents to 143.8 cents, a record high.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 1.2 cents from a record high to 136.0 cents. Prices fell by 9.6 cents in Montreal, 2.0 cents in Quebec City, and less than a cent in Calgary and Edmonton, all from a record high. Prices rose by 6.6 cents in Charlottetown (to a record 140.5 cents), 6.4 cents in Halifax (to a record 142.0 cents), 3.8 cents in Saint John (to a record 136.5 cents), 1.9 cents in Vancouver (to a record 145.8 cents), and less than a cent in Toronto (to a record 132.4 cents) and Regina (to a record 139.9 cents). The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the second straight week, by 2.9 cents to 147.1 cents, a record high.

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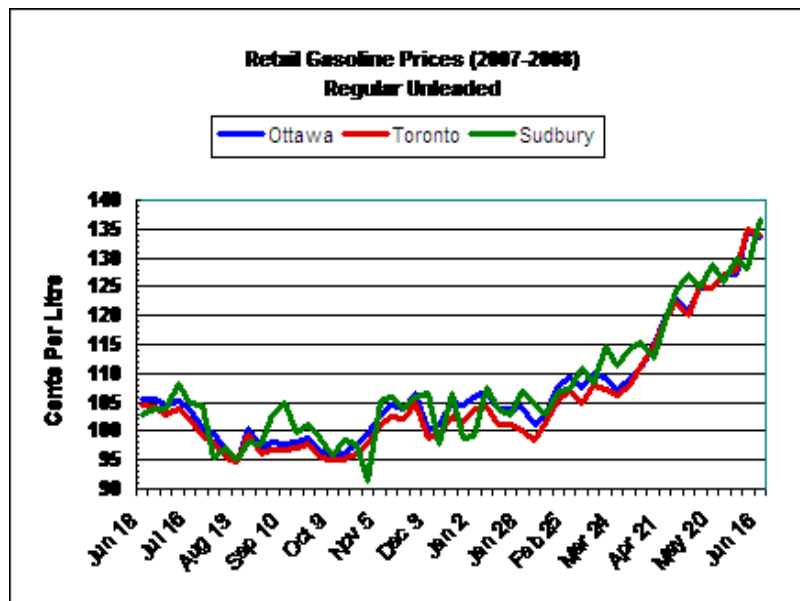
