

Weekly Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending June 23, 2008

After increasing four straight weeks, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 2.3 cents from a record high to 132.1 cents a litre, reflecting lower North American wholesale prices.

Prices fell by 4.2 cents in North Bay (from a 33-month high), 4.0 cents in Sudbury (from a 33-month high), 3.5 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (from a record high), 2.9 cents in Ottawa, 2.5 cents in London, 2.3 cents in Toronto, and 2.0 cents in Timmins (from a record high). Prices rose by less than a cent in Windsor (to a 34-month high) and Thunder Bay (to a record 140.6 cents). The price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed slightly to 5.4 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined by 3.4 cents from a record high to 140.4 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 2.3 cents to 138.4 cents. Prices rose by 8.5 cents in Montreal, 4.5 cents in St. John's (to a 34-month high), 1.4 cents in Saint John (to a record 137.9 cents), 1.2 cents in Halifax (to a record 143.2 cents), 1.0 cents in Toronto (to a record 133.4 cents), and less than a cent in Vancouver (to a record 146.3 cents) and Calgary. Prices fell by 2.0 cents in Quebec City. The Canadian average retail diesel price, after increasing two straight weeks, declined by 2.1 cents from a record high to 145.0 cents.

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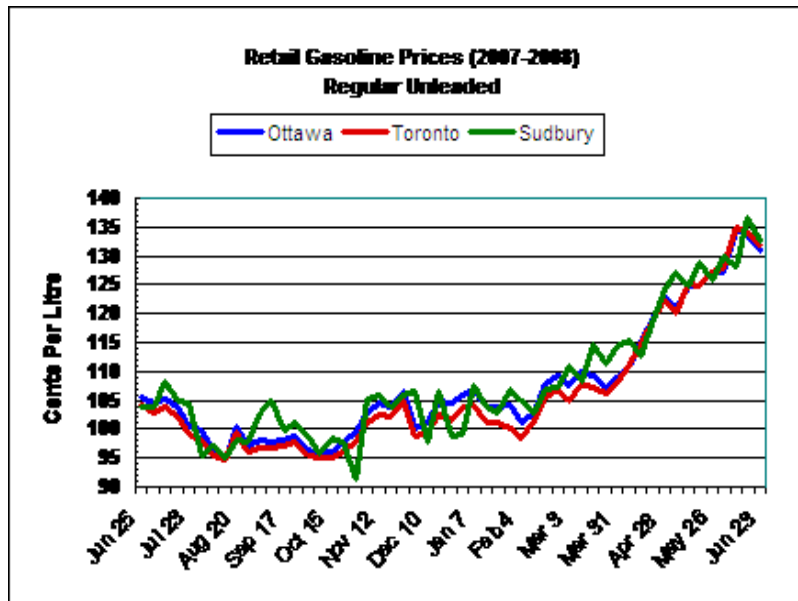
