

Weekly Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending August 11, 2008

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 0.8 cents to 125.7 cents a litre as earlier wholesale price declines flowed through to the pump in northern markets.

Prices fell by 6.5 cents in Sudbury (to a three-month low), 6.1 cents in North Bay (to a three-month low), 1.7 cents in Thunder Bay (to a two-month low), 1.2 cents in Windsor (to a three-month low), 1.0 cents in Timmins (to a three-month low), and less than a cent in Ottawa, Toronto, and London. Ottawa had the lowest average price for the fourth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed for the third straight week, from 7.8 cents to 5.2 cents, a four-week low. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the fourth straight week, by 3.0 cents to 133.4 cents, a three-month low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 1.5 cents to 128.7 cents, a three-month low. Prices fell by 4.6 cents in Montreal (to a four-month low), 3.0 cents in Quebec City (to a four-month low), 2.1 cents in Winnipeg (to a two-month low), 1.9 cents in Edmonton (to a three-month low), 1.3 cents in Halifax (to a three-month low), and less than a cent in Calgary (to a three-month low), Charlottetown (to a three-month low), Toronto (to a three-month low), and Vancouver. Prices rose by 1.2 cents in Saint John (from a three-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the fifth straight week, by 3.1 cents to 137.1 cents, a three-month low.

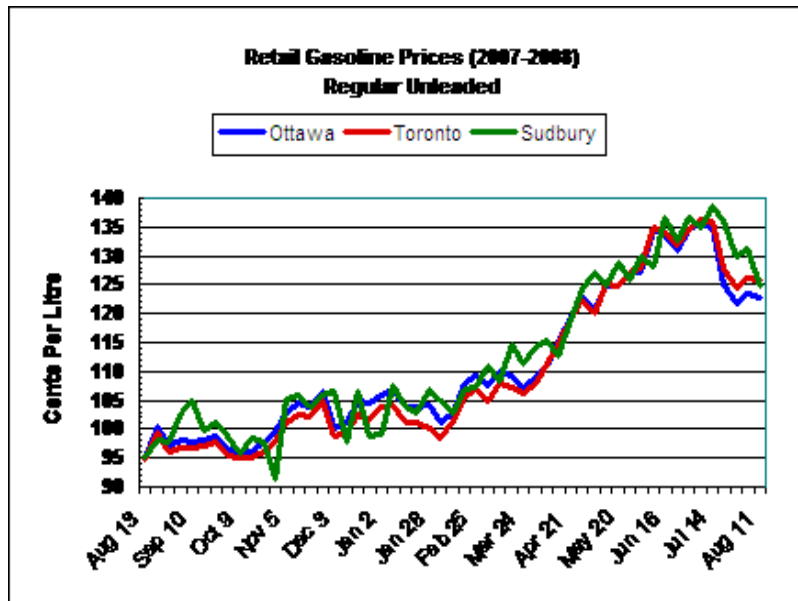
