

Weekly Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending October 14, 2008

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined for the fourth straight week, by 7.8 cents to 102.5 cents a litre, an eight-month low, reflecting lower world crude oil and North American wholesale gasoline prices.

Prices fell by 12.1 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to a seven-month low), 10.1 cents in North Bay (to a seven-month low), 10.0 cents in Sudbury (to a seven-month low), 8.1 cents in Ottawa (to a 12-month low), Windsor (to an eight-month low), and Timmins (to a seven-month low), 7.6 cents in Toronto (to an eight-month low), 7.3 cents in London (to an eight-month low), and 4.7 cents in Thunder Bay (to a six-month low). The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed from a 26-month high of 13.1 cents to 12.1 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the thirteenth straight week, by 2.3 cents to 118.0 cents, a seven-month low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the fourth straight week, by 5.7 cents to 107.9 cents, an eight-month low. Prices fell by 10.4 cents in Edmonton (to an eight-month low), 9.3 cents in Halifax (to an eight-month low), 8.8 cents in Regina (to a seven-month low), 8.4 cents in Saint John (to an eight-month low), 8.3 cents in Calgary (to an eight-month low), 7.8 cents in Quebec City (to an eight-month low), 7.7 cents in Montreal (to an eight-month low), 6.7 cents in Winnipeg (to a seven-month low), 5.4 cents in St. John's (to a six-month low), 5.2 cents in Vancouver (to a seven-month low), and 3.0 cents in Toronto (to an eight-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined by 1.4 cents to 126.4 cents, a seven-month low.

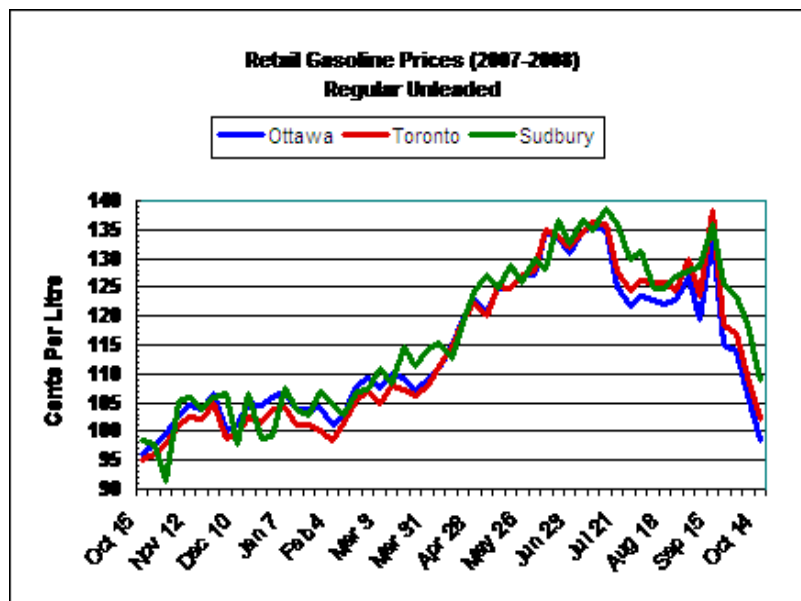
