

Weekly Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending October 20, 2008

World crude oil prices of less than \$70 a barrel and lower wholesale prices caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to decline for the fifth straight week, by 1.2 cents to 101.3 cents a litre, a nine-month low.

Prices fell by 2.6 cents in Timmins (to a seven-month low), 2.5 cents in Thunder Bay (to a six-month low), 2.0 cents in London (to a nine-month low), 1.6 cents in Toronto (to a nine-month low), 1.5 cents in North Bay (to an eight-month low), 1.0 cents in both Sudbury (to an eight-month low) and Sault Ste. Marie (to a seven-month low), and less than a cent in Windsor (to an eight-month low) and Ottawa (to a 12-month low). The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the fourteenth straight week, by 4.1 cents to 113.9 cents, an eight-month low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the fifth straight week, by 2.5 cents to 105.4 cents, an eight-month low. Prices fell by 11.7 cents in Charlottetown (to an 11-month low), 8.4 cents in St. John's (to an eight-month low), 5.9 cents in Edmonton (to an eight-month low), 5.8 cents in Vancouver (to an eight-month low), 4.9 cents in Calgary (to an eight-month low), 4.3 cents in Quebec City (to an 11-month low), 4.0 cents in Saint John (to an eight-month low), 3.9 cents in Regina (to an eight-month low), 3.8 cents in Montreal (to an 11-month low), 3.2 cents in Winnipeg (to an eight-month low), and 2.2 cents in Halifax (to an eight-month low). Prices rose by 0.8 cents in Toronto (from an eight-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the second straight week, by 5.4 cents to 121.0 cents, a seven-month low.

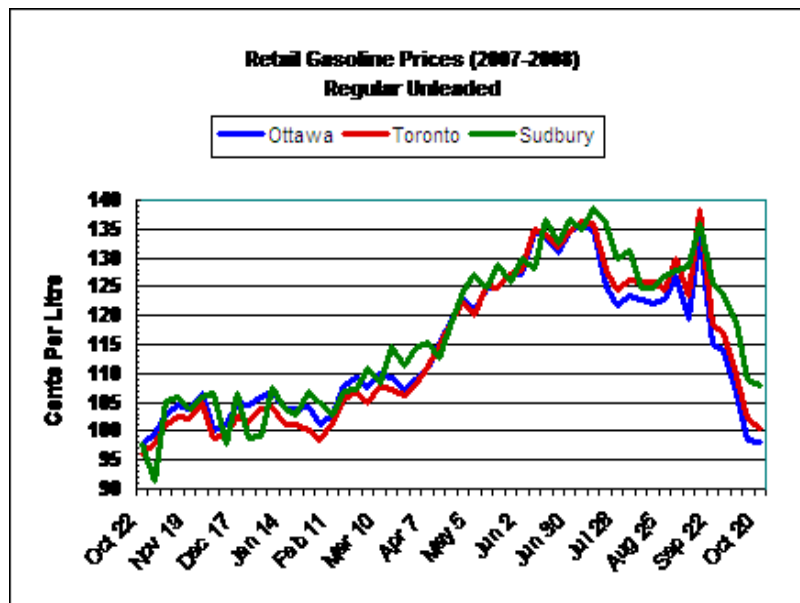
