

Weekly Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending November 10, 2008

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined for the eighth straight week, by 6.9 cents to 85.0 cents a litre, a 21-month low, reflecting lower wholesale prices and crude oil prices that briefly fell below US\$60 a barrel.

Prices fell by 8.0 cents in Thunder Bay (to a thirteen-month low), 7.5 cents in Toronto (to a 21-month low), 6.7 cents in London (to a 21-month low), 6.4 cents in Sault Ste. Marie and North Bay (both to a 21-month low), 6.3 cents in Windsor (to a 21-month low), 6.2 cents in Sudbury (to a 21-month low), 5.8 cents in Timmins (to a 21-month low), and 5.6 cents in Ottawa (to a 22-month low). Ottawa had the lowest average price for the sixth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened slightly for the second straight week, to 11.0 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the 17th straight week, by 3.2 cents to 105.7 cents, a twelve-month low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the eighth straight week, by 4.0 cents to 88.7 cents, a 21-month low. Prices fell by 7.6 cents in Regina (to a 21-month low), 7.3 cents in Quebec City (to a 21-month low), 7.2 cents in Vancouver (to a 21-month low), 7.1 cents in Calgary and Edmonton (both to a 21-month low), 6.6 cents in Montreal (to a 25-month low), 5.9 cents in Halifax (to a 21-month low), 5.8 cents in Saint John and St. John's (both to a 21-month low), and 3.0 cents in Winnipeg (to a 21-month low). Prices rose by 0.2 cents in Toronto (from a 21-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the fifth straight week, by 2.8 cents to 114.7 cents, a nine-month low.

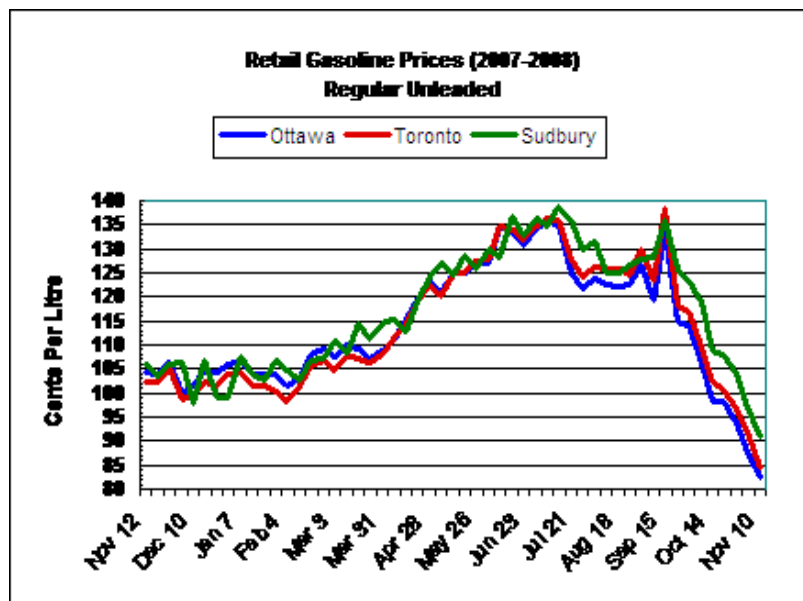
