

Weekly Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending November 17, 2008

The pass-through of earlier wholesale price declines, particularly in the north, caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to decline for the ninth straight week, by 1.4 cents to 83.6 cents a litre, a 22-month low.

Prices fell by 5.5 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to a 22-month low), 3.1 cents in North Bay and Timmins (both to a 21-month low), 2.5 cents in Sudbury (to a 21-month low), 1.7 cents in London (to a 22-month low), 1.5 cents in Toronto (to a 22-month low), 1.4 cents in Thunder Bay (to a 21-month low), and 1.2 cents in Ottawa (to a 44-month low). Prices rose by 3.1 cents in Windsor (from a 21-month low). The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the 18th straight week, by 2.1 cents to 103.6 cents, a twelve-month low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the ninth straight week, by 3.3 cents to 85.4 cents, a 22-month low. Prices fell by 7.3 cents in Charlottetown (to a 45-month low), 5.8 cents in St. John's (to a 21-month low), 5.7 cents in Saint John (to a 21-month low), 5.4 cents in Winnipeg (to a 21-month low), 5.2 cents in Quebec City (to a 21-month low), 5.0 cents in Halifax (to a 45-month low), 4.1 cents in Toronto (to a 22-month low), 3.2 cents in Montreal (to a 45-month low), 2.4 cents in Edmonton (to a 21-month low), 2.0 cents in Regina (to a 21-month low), 1.8 cents in Calgary (to a 21-month low), and 1.2 cents in Vancouver (to a 21-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the sixth straight week, by 3.7 cents to 111.0 cents, a nine-month low.

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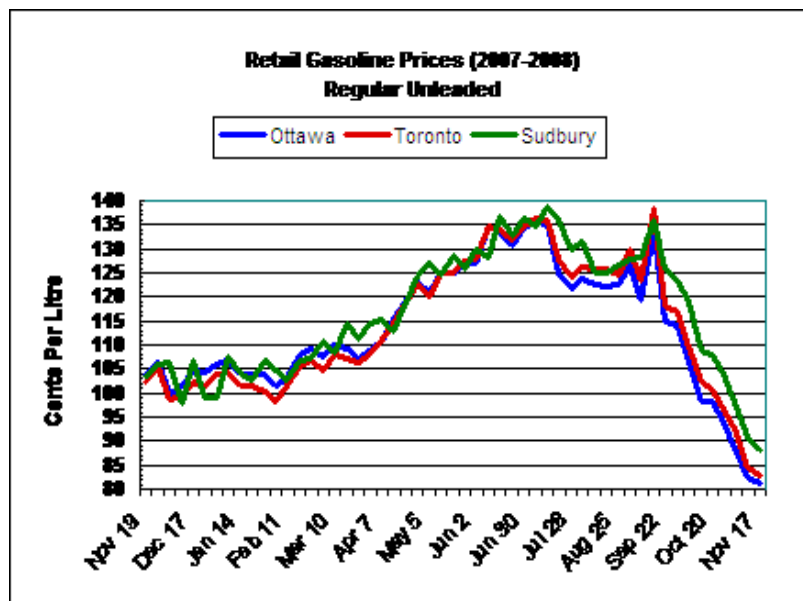
