Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly.

This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending September 14, 2009

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined for the second straight week, by 1.0 cents to 93.9 cents a litre, a two-month low, reflecting lower wholesale prices.

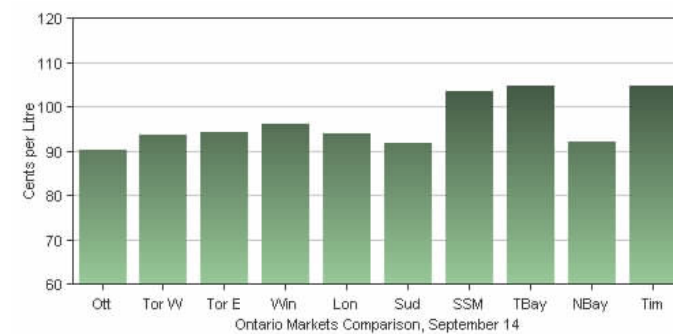
Prices fell by 2.1 cents in Sudbury (to a two-month low), 1.6 cents in North Bay (to a two-month low), 1.3 cents in Ottawa and London (both to a two-month low), 1.2 cents in Toronto (to a two-month low), 1.1 cents in Timmins (to a two-month low), and 0.9 cents in Thunder Bay (to a six-week low). Prices rose by 3.4 cents in Windsor (from a five-week low) and 0.1 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to an 11-month high). The Ontario average retail diesel price was unchanged at a five-week low of 90.1 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the second straight week, by 0.2 cents to 99.2 cents, a two-month low. Prices fell by 3.9 cents in Charlottetown (to a two-month low), 2.0 cents in Halifax, Saint John, and Regina (all to a six-week low), 1.3 cents in St. John's (to a five-week low), Quebec City (to a two-month low), and Toronto (to a two-month low), and 0.2 cents in Calgary (to a six-week low). Prices rose by 2.3 cents in Montreal (from a two-month low) and less than a cent in Vancouver and Winnipeg. The Canadian average retail diesel price fell by 0.9 cents to 91.6 cents, a six-week low.

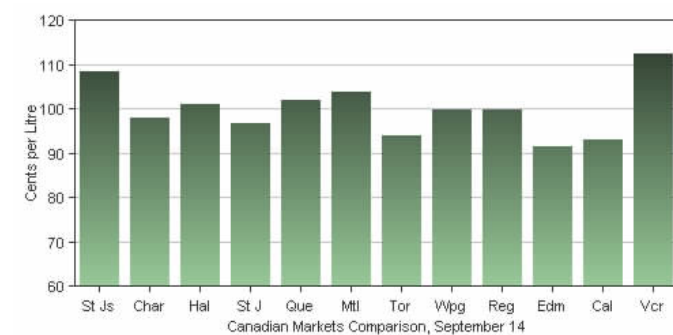

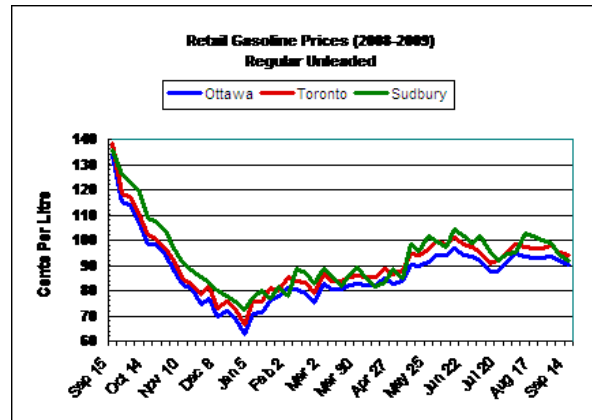
