Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending November 9, 2009.

Lower North American wholesale prices and price wars in some markets caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to decline for the second straight week, by 1.7 cents to 97.2 cents a litre.

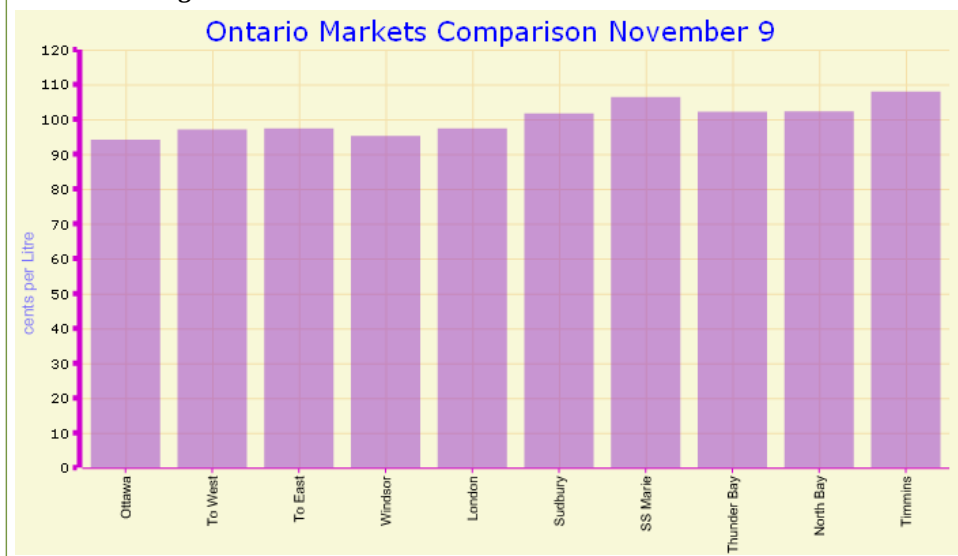
Prices fell by 3.9 cents in both Windsor (from a four-month high) and North Bay (from a 12-month high), 2.1 cents in Ottawa, 2.0 cents in both Toronto and London, and less than a cent in Thunder Bay (from a six-week high) and Sault Ste. Marie (from a 12-month high). Prices rose by 9.8 cents in Sudbury (to a three-month high). The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened for the second straight week, from 2.2 cents to 6.7 cents, a six-week high. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after increasing three straight weeks, was unchanged at an 11-month high of 94.8 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after increasing three straight weeks, declined by 1.4 cents from a four-month high to 100.7 cents. Prices fell by 5.0 cents in Regina, 1.9 cents in Halifax (from a four-month high), 1.4 cents in Toronto, 1.3 cents in Vancouver (from a six-week high), 1.2 cents in Edmonton (to a four-week low), 1.1 cents in St. John's (from a four-month high), 1.1 cents in Montreal (from a six-week high), 1.1 cents in Calgary (from a two-month high), and 1.0 cents in Saint John (from a four-month high). Prices rose by 0.1 cents in Winnipeg. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the fifth straight week, by 1.1 cents to 97.5 cents, the highest since December 2008.

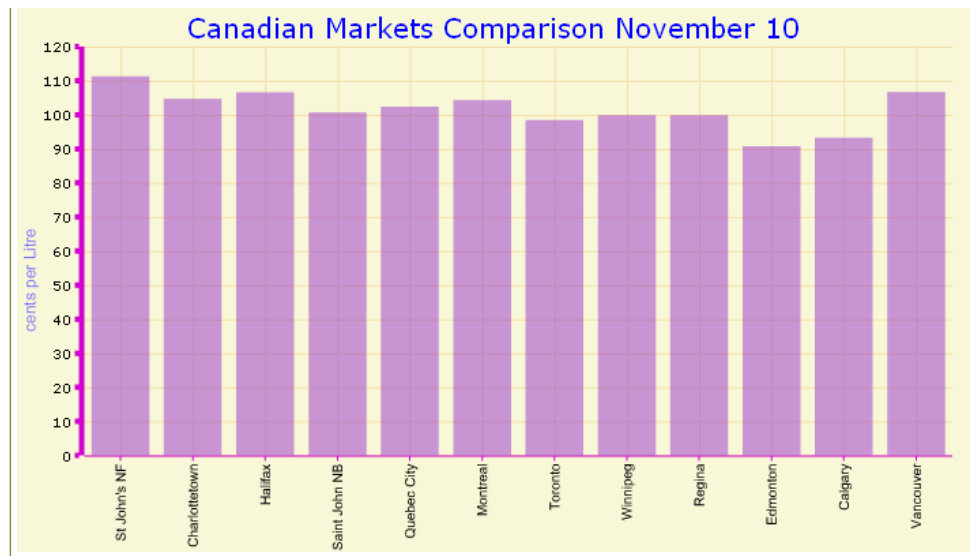

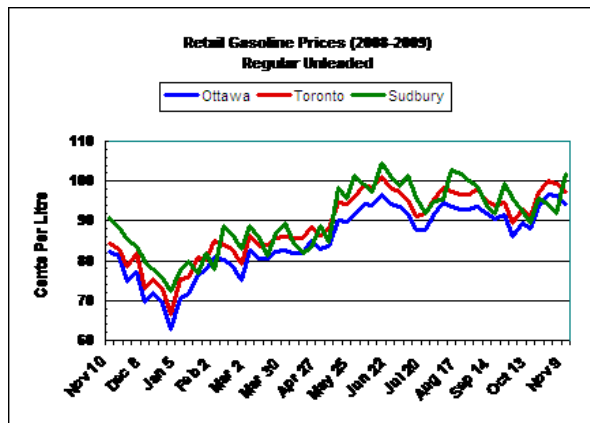
