Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending November 16, 2009.

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined for the third straight week, by 1.4 cents to 95.8 cents a litre, a five-week low, as world crude oil and North American wholesale prices weakened.

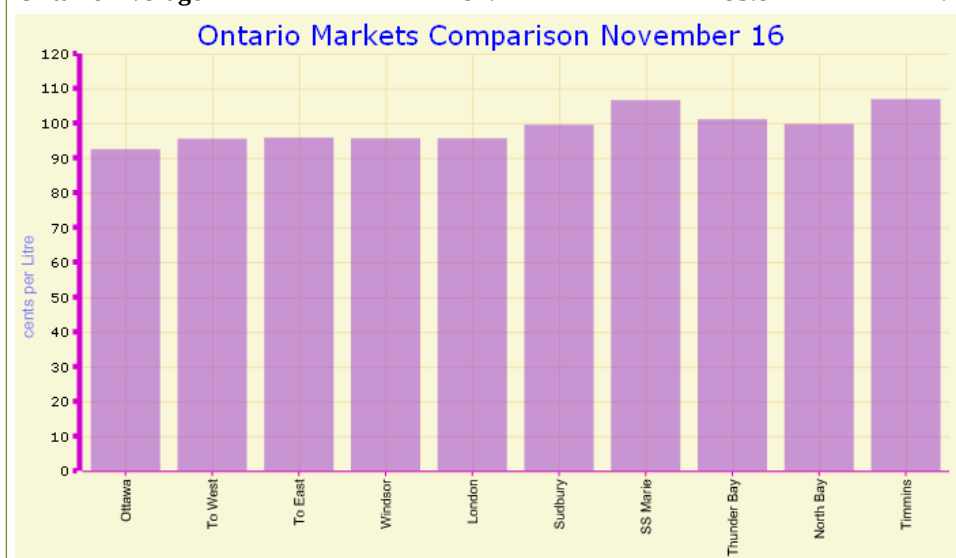
Prices fell by 2.6 cents in North Bay, 2.2 cents in Sudbury (from a three-month high), 1.8 cents in London, 1.6 cents in both Ottawa and Toronto, 1.1 cents in Thunder Bay, and 1.0 cents in Timmins. Prices rose by less than a cent in Windsor and Sault Ste. Marie. Ottawa was the lowest-priced market for the second straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened for the third straight week, to 6.8 cents, a two-month high. The Ontario average retail diesel price fell by 0.3 cents from an 11-month high to 94.5 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the second straight week, by 0.9 cents to 99.8 cents, a four-week low. Prices fell by 3.8 cents in Charlottetown, 3.7 cents in Calgary, 2.8 cents in Edmonton, 2.5 cents in Halifax, 2.1 cents in both Saint John and Winnipeg, 2.0 cents in Regina, 1.1 cents in Toronto, and less than a cent in Quebec City and Vancouver. Prices rose by 1.7 cents in Montreal, to a two-month high. The Canadian average retail diesel price, after increasing five straight weeks, was unchanged at an 11-month high of 97.5 cents.

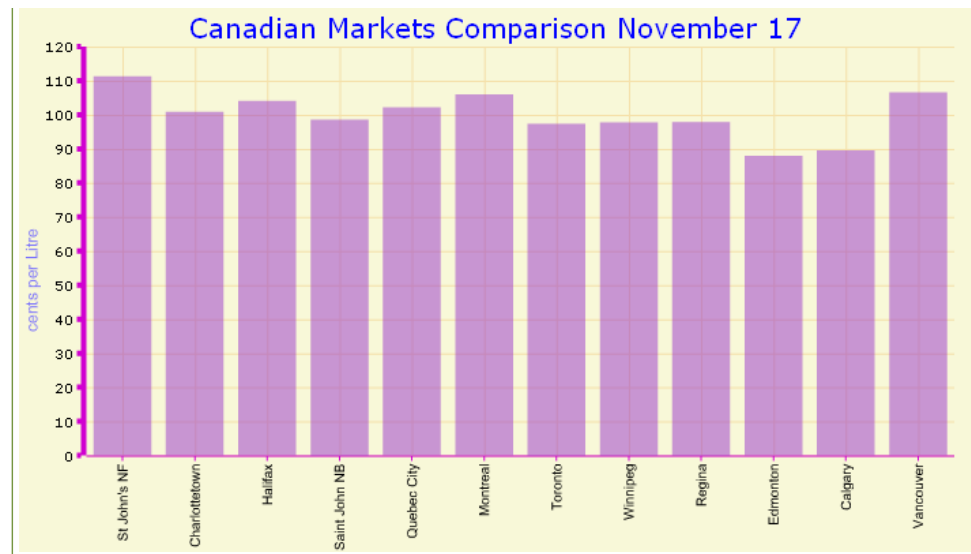

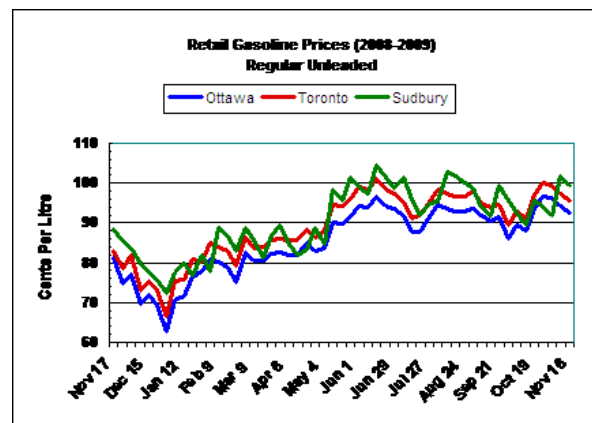
