Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending November 23, 2009.

Price increases in southern Ontario outweighed decreases in the north, causing the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to increase by 1.9 cents from a five-week low to 97.7 cents a litre.

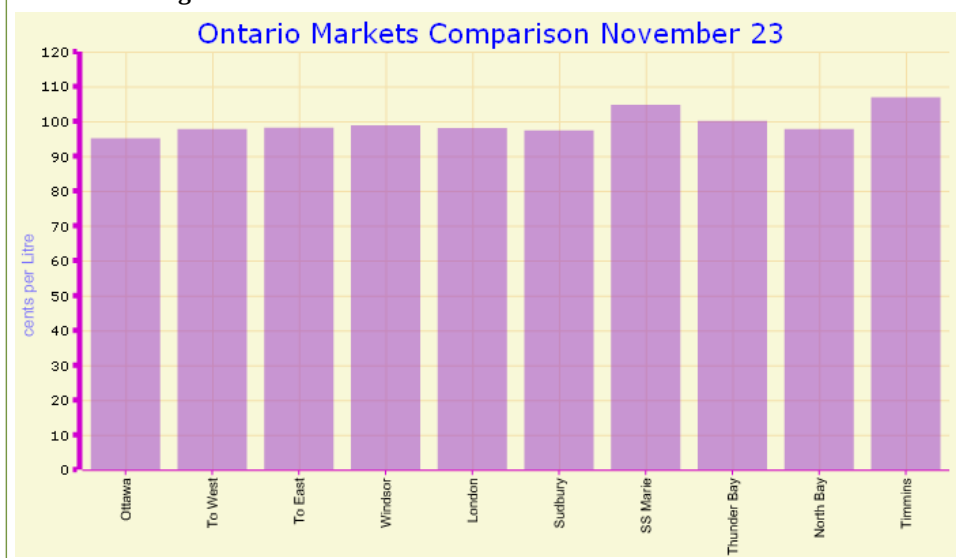
Prices rose by 3.2 cents in Windsor, 2.6 cents in Ottawa, 2.4 cents in London, and 2.3 cents in Toronto. Prices fell by 2.1 cents in Sudbury, 1.9 cents in both Sault Ste. Marie (to a four-week low) and North Bay (to a five-week low), and 1.0 cents in Thunder Bay (to a four-week low). Ottawa was the lowest-priced market for the third straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario, after widening three straight weeks, narrowed to 2.9 cents from a two-month high of 6.8 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price fell for the second straight week, by 0.4 cents to 94.1 cents, a four-week low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 0.6 cents from a four-week low to 100.4 cents. Prices rose by 3.4 cents in Montreal (to a 14-month high) and 1.1 cents in Vancouver. Prices fell by 2.8 cents in Quebec City (to a six-week low), 2.2 cents in St. John's, and less than a cent in Winnipeg (to a five-week low), Saint John (to a four-week low), and Toronto (to a six-week low). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined by 0.5 cents from an 11-month high to 97.0 cents.

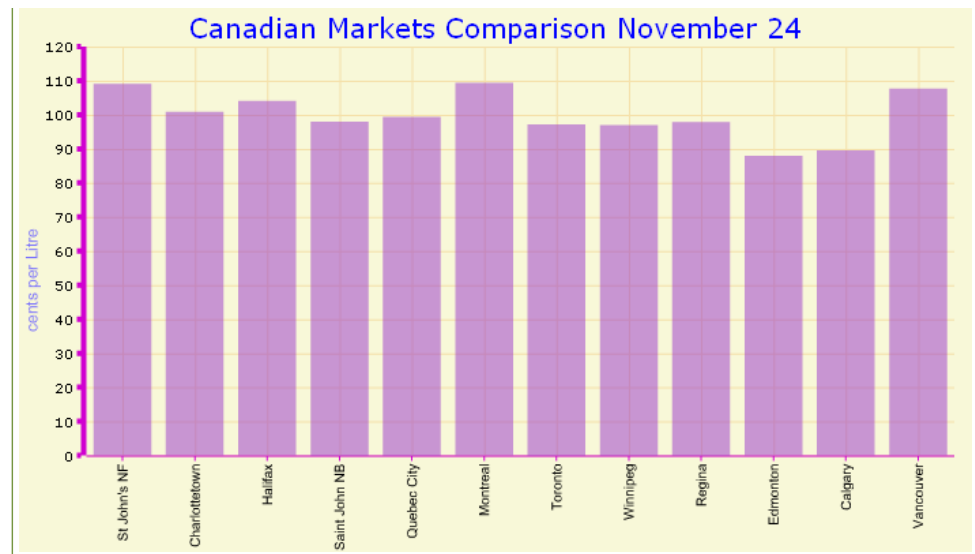

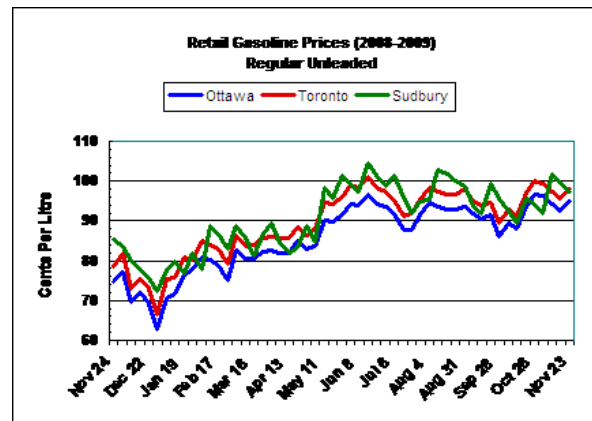
