GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending November 30, 2009.

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 0.4 cents to 97.3 cents a litre, reflecting price wars in several markets and slightly lower wholesale prices.

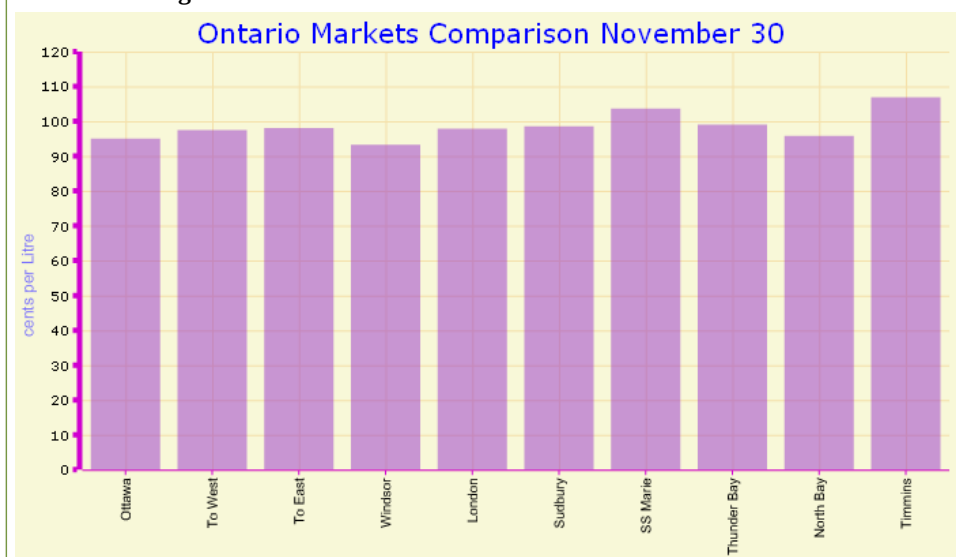
Prices fell by 5.6 cents in Windsor (to a two-month low), 2.0 cents in North Bay (to a two-month low), 1.1 cents in Sault Ste. Marie and Thunder Bay (both to a five-week low), and less than a cent in Toronto, Ottawa, and London. Prices rose by 1.1 cents in Sudbury. Windsor ended Ottawa's three-week run as the lowest-priced market. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened slightly to 3.0 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after falling two straight weeks, increased by 0.1 cents from a four-week low to 94.2 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 2.2 cents to 98.2 cents, a two-month low. Prices fell by 9.4 cents in Montreal (from a 14-month high), 2.2 cents in Calgary (to a two-month low), 2.0 cents in both Edmonton (to a two-month low) and Regina (to a six-week low), 1.0 cents in Vancouver, and 0.1 cents in Winnipeg (to a six-week low). Prices rose by 1.3 cents in Saint John (from a four-week low) and 0.5 cents in Toronto (from a six-week low). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the second straight week, by 0.8 cents to 96.2 cents, a five-week low.

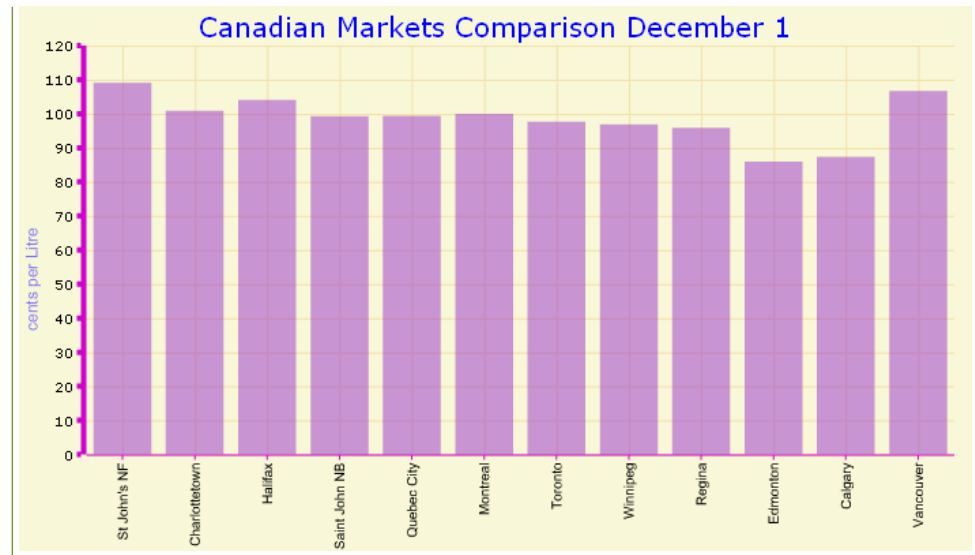

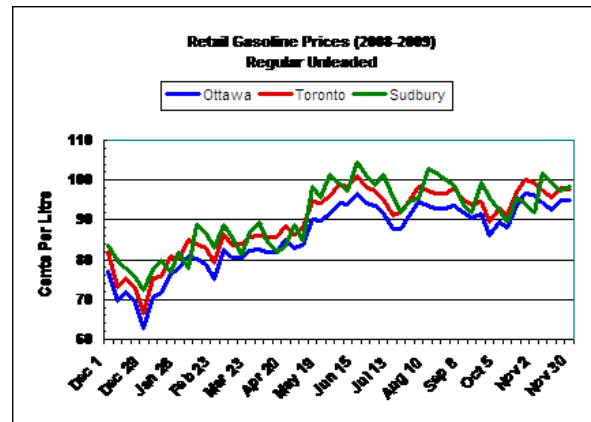
