Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending December 7, 2009.

Despite higher North American wholesale prices, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined for the second straight week, by 1.3 cents to 96.0 cents a litre.

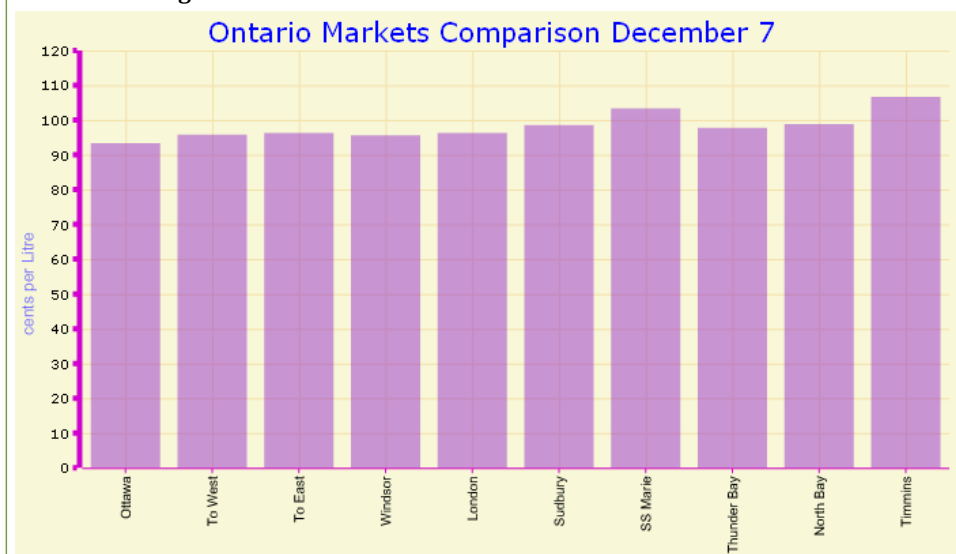
Prices fell by 1.7 cents in both Ottawa and Toronto, 1.6 cents in London, 1.2 cents in Thunder Bay (to a six-week low), and less than a cent in Sault Ste. Marie and Timmins (both to a six-week low). Prices rose by 3.0 cents in North Bay and 2.4 cents in Windsor (both from a two-month low). The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened from 3.0 cents to 4.3 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined by 0.3 cents to 93.9 cents, a six-week low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the second straight week, by 0.9 cents to 97.3 cents, a two-month low. Prices fell by 2.3 cents in Toronto, 1.2 cents in Halifax, and less than a cent in Vancouver and Winnipeg (all to a two-month low). Prices rose by 2.5 cents in Quebec City, 1.2 cents in St. John's, 1.0 cents in Edmonton (from a two-month low), and less than a cent in Montreal (from a two-month low) and Saint John (to a four-week high). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the third straight week, by 0.4 cents to 95.8 cents, a six-week low.

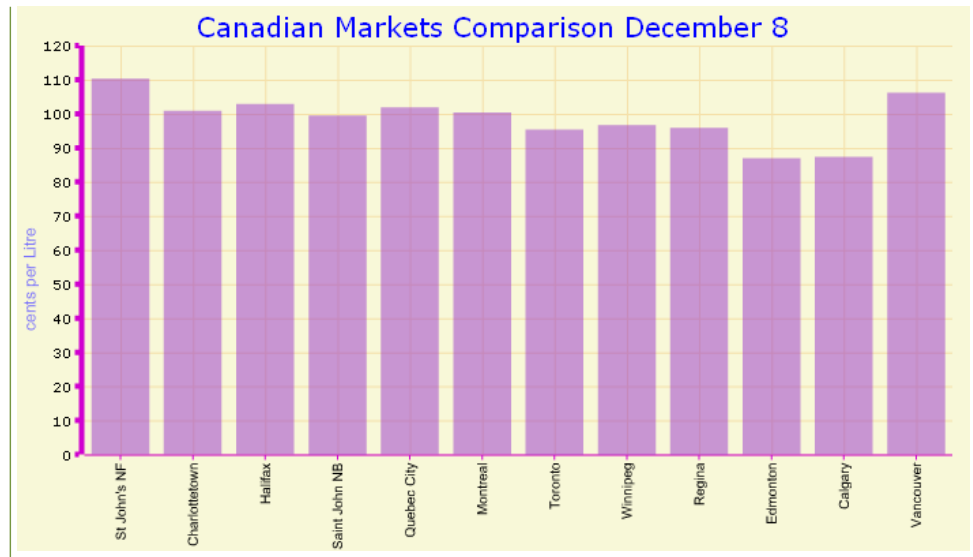

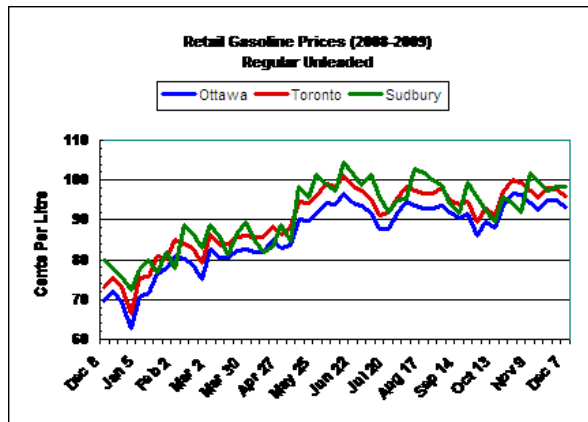
