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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending December 14, 2009.

Significant declines in world crude oil and North American wholesale prices caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to decline for the third straight week, by 4.6 cents to 91.4 cents a litre, a two-month low.

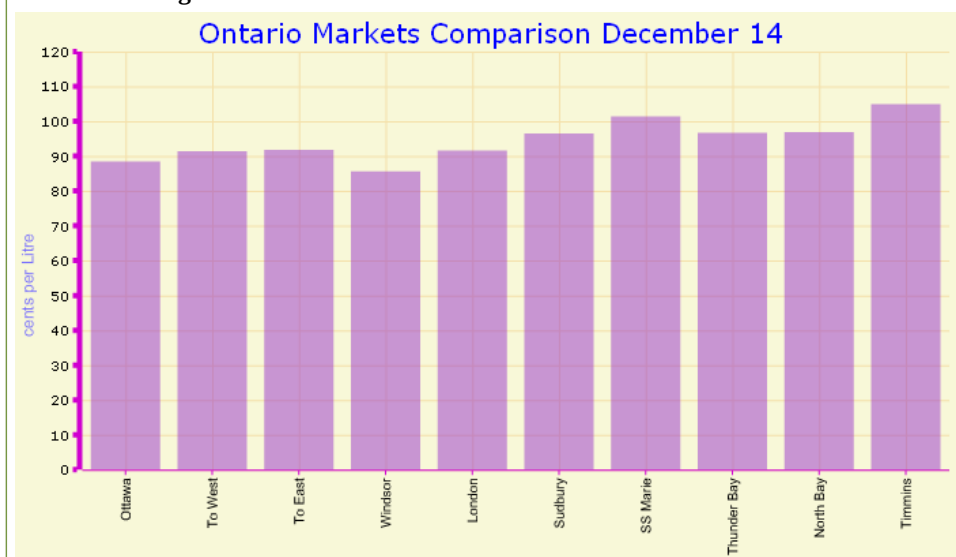
Prices fell by 10.0 cents in Windsor (to a seven-month low), 4.9 cents in Ottawa (to a two-month low), 4.7 cents in London (to a two-month low), 4.5 cents in Toronto (to a two-month low), 2.0 cents in Sudbury (to a six-week low), 1.9 cents in both Sault Ste. Marie (to a two-month low) and North Bay, 1.8 cents in Timmins (to a two-month low), and 1.1 cents in Thunder Bay (to a seven-month low). The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the second straight week, by 0.9 cents to 93.0 cents, a two-month low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the third straight week, by 2.6 cents to 94.7 cents, a two-month low. Prices fell by 5.0 cents in Charlottetown (to a two-month low), 3.7 cents in Toronto (to a two-month low), 3.6 cents in Halifax (to a two-month low), 3.0 cents in Edmonton (to a seven-month low), 2.9 cents in Vancouver (to a two-month low), 2.5 cents in Quebec City, 2.0 cents in Regina (to a seven-month low), 1.7 cents in Saint John (to a two-month low), 1.7 cents in Montreal (to a two-month low), and 1.7 cents in Calgary (to a seven-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the fourth straight week, by 1.1 cents to 94.7 cents, a two-month low.

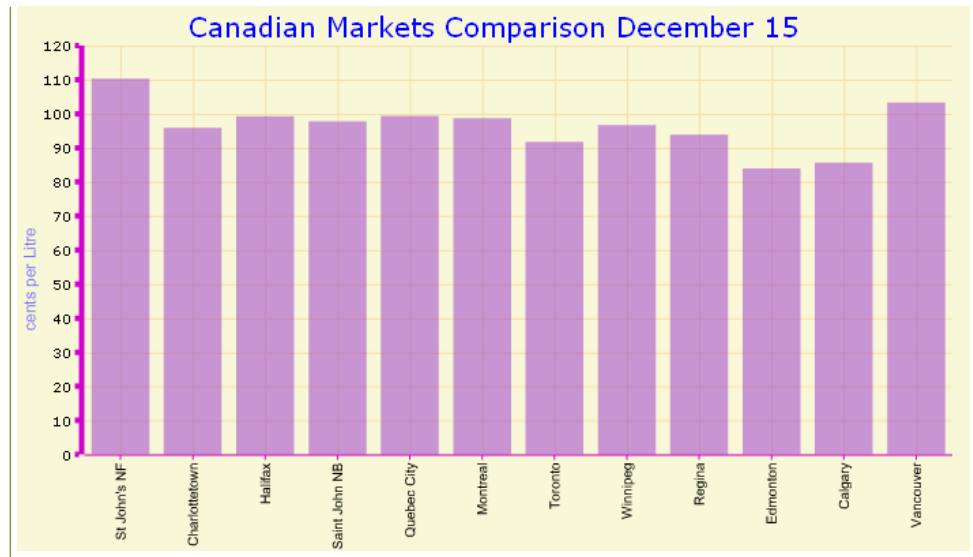

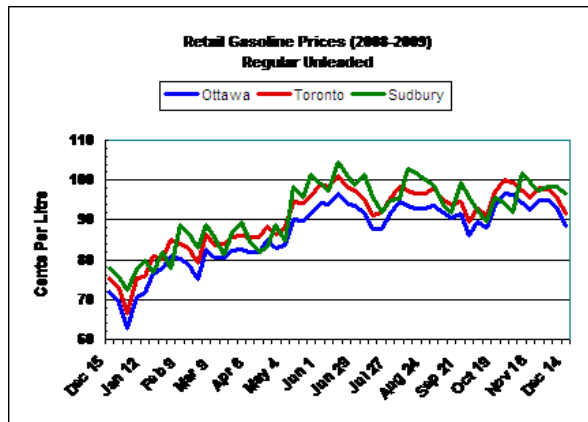
