Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending January 25, 2010.

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined for the second straight week, by 1.1 cents to 96.2 cents a litre, a four-week low, reflecting lower world crude oil and North American wholesale prices.

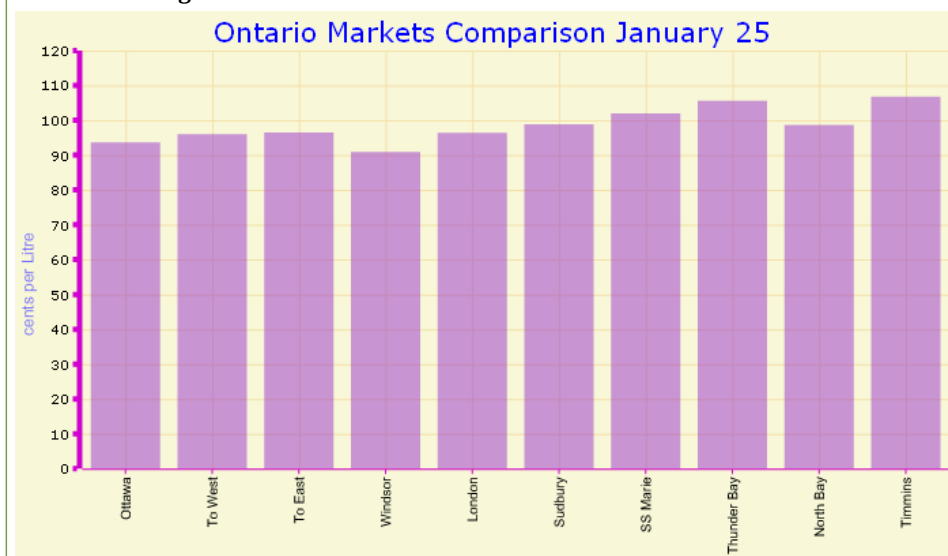
Prices fell by 3.1 cents in Windsor, 2.3 cents in Sudbury, 2.2 cents in North Bay, 1.3 cents in Sault Ste. Marie, 1.1 cents in Toronto, London, and Timmins (the latter from a two-month high), 1.0 cents in Ottawa, and 0.3 cents in Thunder Bay (from a five-month high). Windsor had the lowest average price for the seventh straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed slightly to 6.6 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the second straight week, by 1.6 cents to 95.8 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 0.2 cents to 99.8 cents. Prices rose by 1.2 cents in Vancouver and less than a cent in Montreal, Toronto, and Winnipeg (the latter to a three-month high). Prices fell by 2.8 cents in Saint John (from a seven-month high), 2.0 cents in Halifax, 1.0 cents in Quebec City, and less than a cent in Regina and Calgary. The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the second straight week, by 1.9 cents to 98.5 cents.

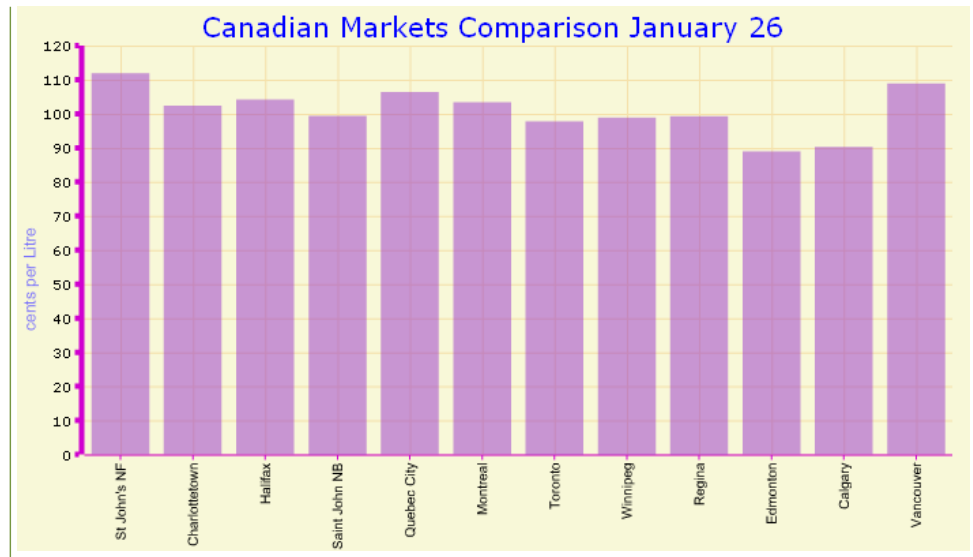

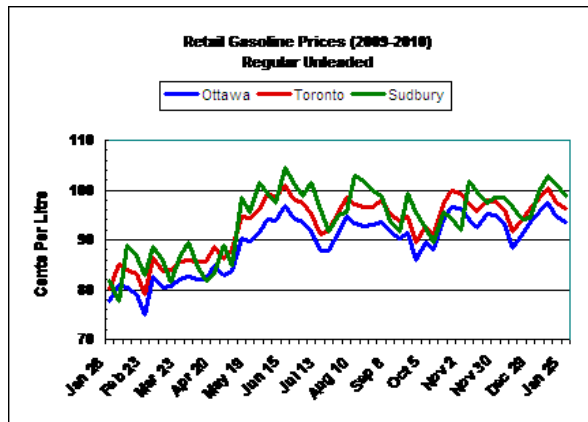
