Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending February 8, 2010.

Despite higher wholesale prices and large pump price jumps in Sudbury and North Bay, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined for the fourth straight week, by 0.8 cents to 95.1 cents a litre, a two-month low.

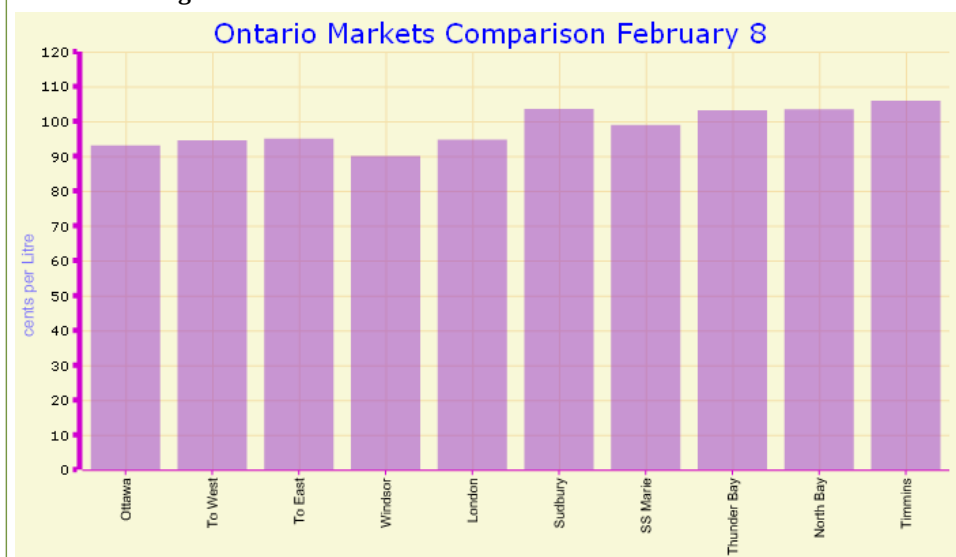
Prices fell by 3.5 cents in Windsor, 1.6 cents in both London (to a two-month low) and Sault Ste. Marie, 1.4 cents in Thunder Bay, 1.2 cents in Toronto (to a two-month low), and 0.1 cents in Ottawa (to a two-month low). Prices rose by 6.8 cents in Sudbury (to an eight-month high) and 6.5 cents in North Bay (to a three-month high). The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario, after shrinking two straight weeks, widened from 5.2 cents to 8.7 cents, a four-month high. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the fourth straight week, by 0.6 cents to 94.1 cents, a six-week low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the second straight week, by 0.2 cents to 98.5 cents, a six-week low. Prices fell by 1.5 cents in Vancouver, 1.2 cents in St. John's, and less than a cent in Saint John, Edmonton (to a two-month low), Toronto (to a two-month low), Calgary (to a two-month low), and Winnipeg. Prices rose by 3.0 cents in Regina and less than a cent in Halifax and Montreal. The Canadian average retail diesel price, after declining three straight weeks, increased by 0.3 cents from a five-week low to 96.9 cents.

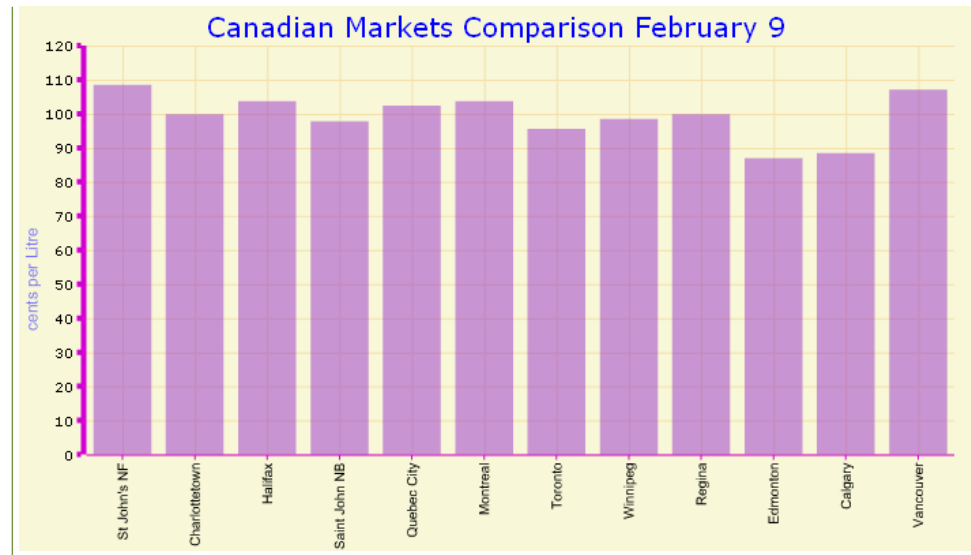

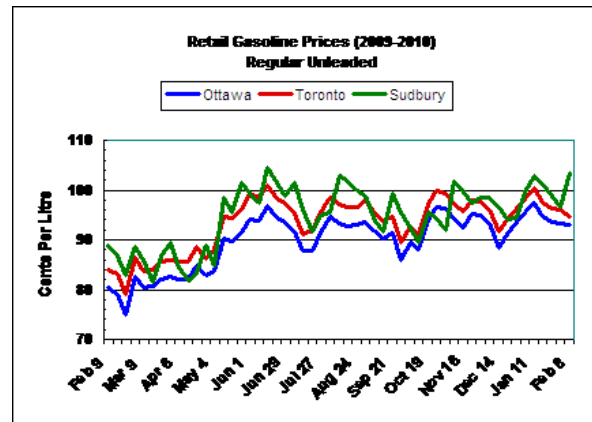
