Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending February 16, 2010.

Lower prices in Windsor and some northern cities caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to decline for the fifth straight week, by 0.2 cents to 94.9 cents a litre, a two-month low.

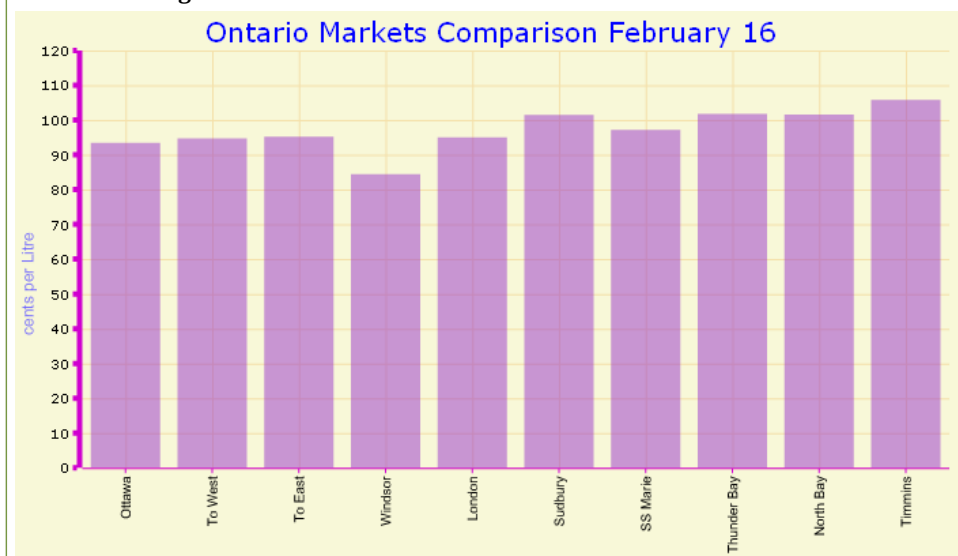
Prices fell by 5.6 cents in Windsor (to a nine-month low), 2.0 cents in Sudbury (from an eight-month high), 1.8 cents in North Bay (from a three-month high), 1.7 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to a six-month low), 1.3 cents in Thunder Bay, and 0.1 cents in Timmins. Prices rose by less than a cent in Ottawa, London, and Toronto, all from a two-month low. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed from a four-month high of 8.7 cents to 7.3 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the fifth straight week, by 0.4 cents to 93.7 cents, a three-month low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after declining two straight weeks, was unchanged at a six-week low of 98.5 cents. Prices rose by 2.1 cents in Vancouver, but fell by 2.6 cents in Halifax (to a two-month low) and less than a cent in Montreal, Calgary (to a two-month low), Toronto (to a two-month low), Saint John (to a two-month low), and St. John's. The Canadian average retail diesel price was unchanged at a five-week low of 96.9 cents.

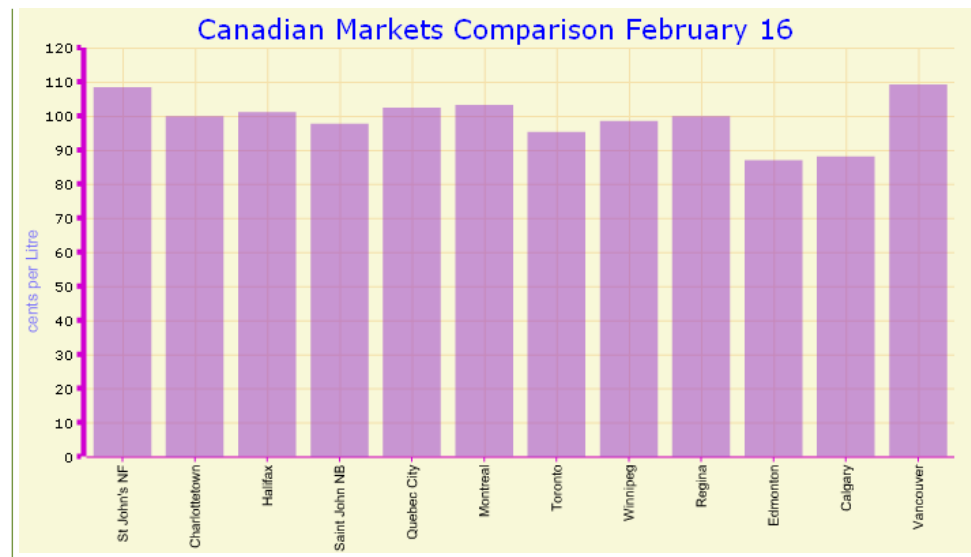

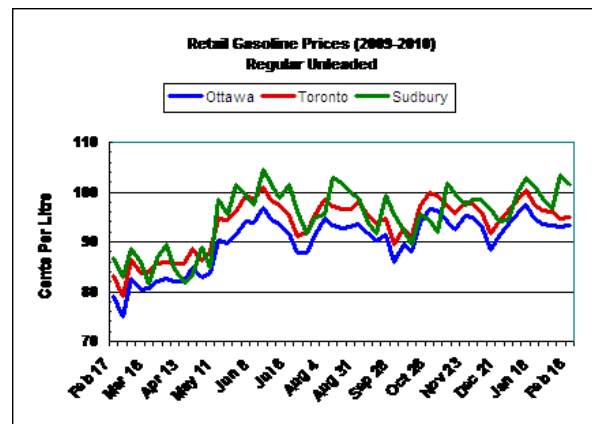
