



## GASOLINE REPORT

### Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending April 26, 2010.

**Despite lower domestic wholesale prices, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline, after declining two straight weeks, increased by 1.2 cents to 100.4 cents a litre.**

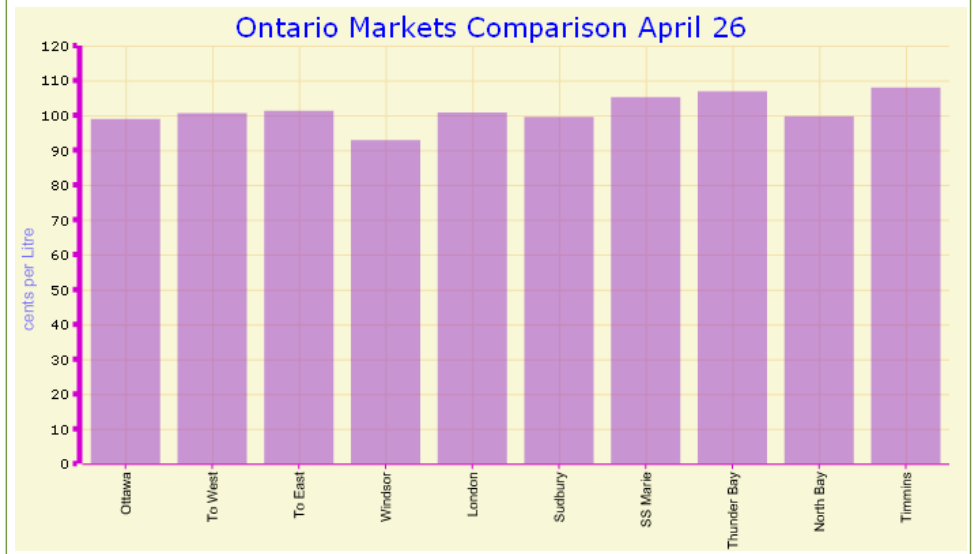
Prices rose by 1.8 cents in Ottawa, 1.6 cents in both Toronto and London, and 0.1 cents in North Bay (to a three-month high). Prices fell by 1.6 cents in Windsor (to a two-month low), 1.0 cents in Timmins, and 0.3 cents in Sudbury (to a four-month low). Windsor had the lowest average price for the twelfth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed for the second straight week, from 5.0 cents to 3.4 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price was unchanged at 96.5 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after declining two straight weeks, increased by 0.9 cents to 104.5 cents. Prices rose by 1.6 cents in both Toronto and Vancouver (the latter to an 18-month high), 1.0 cents in Montreal (to a two-month high), and 0.1 cents in Winnipeg. Prices fell by 1.9 cents in Halifax (to a two-month low) and less than a cent in St. John's and Saint John. The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the second straight week, by 0.3 cents to 99.7 cents.

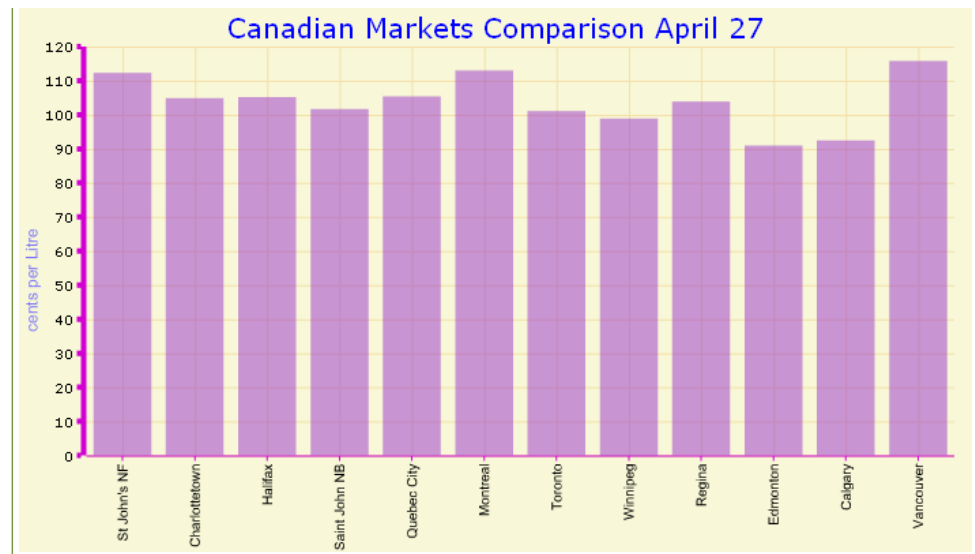

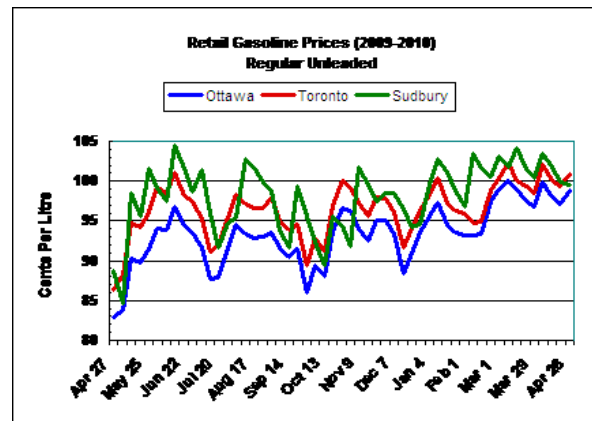
