Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending May 3, 2010.

Higher North American wholesale prices helped push up the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline by 1.6 cents to 102.0 cents a litre, an 18-month high.

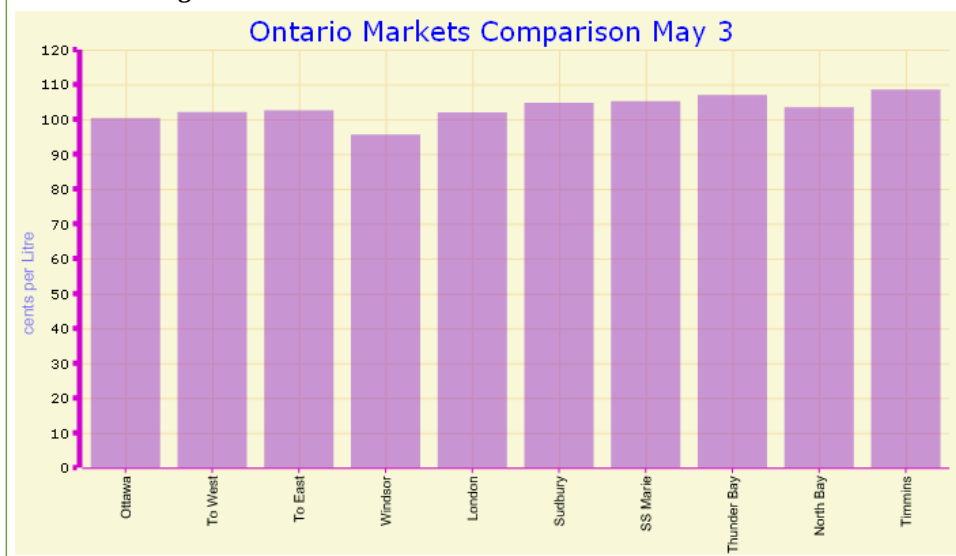
Prices rose by 5.2 cents from a three-month low in Sudbury (to an 18-month high), 3.7 cents in North Bay, 2.7 cents in Windsor (from a two-month low), 1.4 cents in Ottawa and Toronto (both to a 19-month high), 1.2 cents in London (to a two-month high), and less than a cent in Timmins and Thunder Bay (the latter to an eight-month high). The Ontario average retail diesel price increased by 0.3 cents to 96.8 cents, a four-month high.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased for the second straight week, by 0.7 cents to 105.2 cents, an 18-month high. Prices rose by 6.0 cents in Edmonton (to an 18-month high), 5.9 cents in Calgary (to an 18-month high), 4.0 cents in Regina (to a 10-month high), 2.7 cents in Toronto (to a 19-month high), 2.4 cents in Halifax (from a two-month low), 1.1 cents in St. John's, 1.0 cents in Saint John, and 0.4 cents in Vancouver (to a 19-month high). Prices fell by 7.2 cents in Montreal (from a two-month high). The Canadian average retail diesel price, after declining two straight weeks, increased by 1.2 cents to 100.9 cents, a 17-month high.

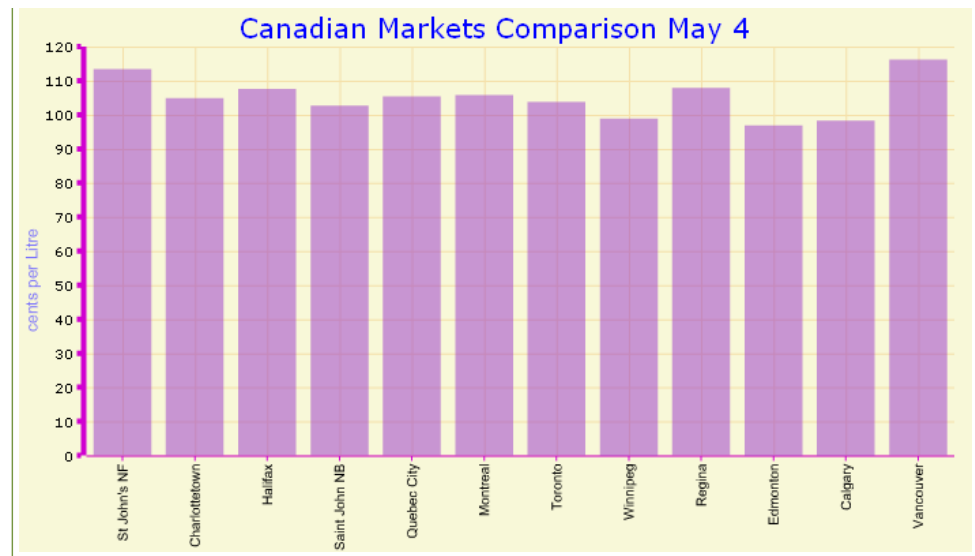

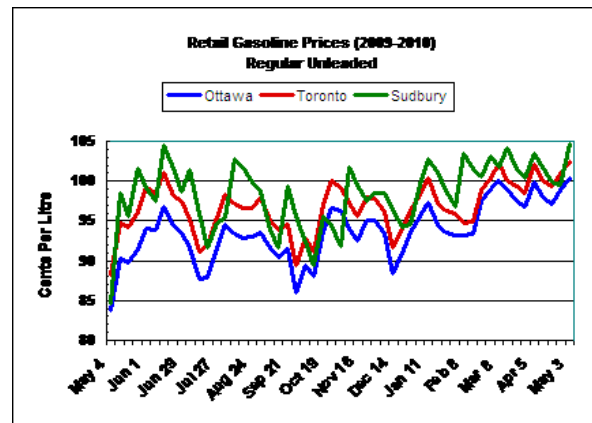
