Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending May 17, 2010.

Higher North American wholesale prices and the end of price wars in some markets caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to increase by 2.3 cents from a three-month low to 99.0 cents a litre.

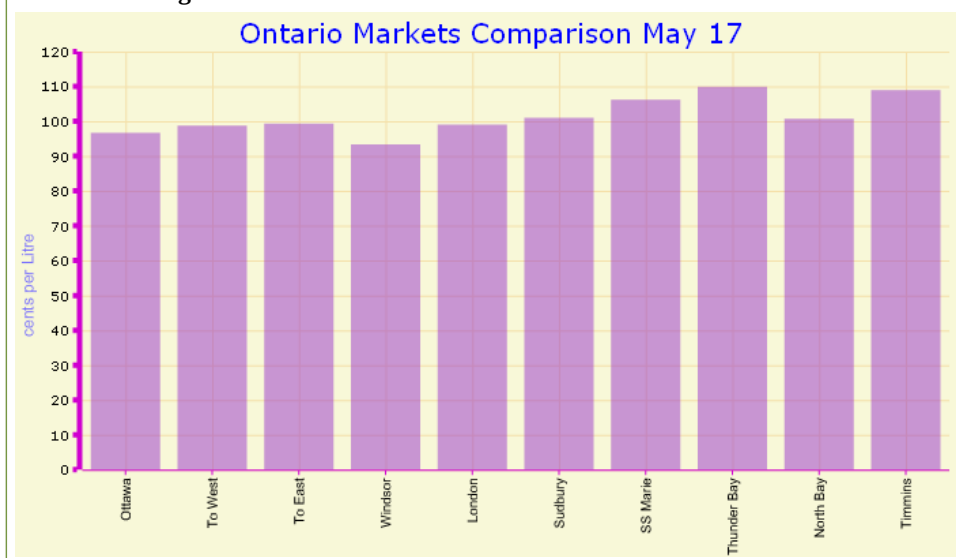
Prices rose by 3.6 cents in Windsor (from a three-month low), 2.9 cents in London (from a three-month low), 2.8 cents in Ottawa and Toronto (both from a three-month low), and 0.1 cents in Thunder Bay (to a 19-month high). Prices fell by 3.6 cents in Sudbury and 3.4 cents in North Bay (from a six-month high). The Ontario average retail diesel price, after increasing two straight weeks, declined by 0.2 cents from a four-month high to 96.9 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the second straight week, by 1.6 cents to 101.3 cents, a three-month low. Prices fell by 4.6 cents from a 19-month high in Saint John (to a three-month low), 4.5 cents from a 19-month high in St. John's (to a three-month low), 4.0 cents in Quebec City (from a 19-month high), 3.4 cents in Halifax (to a three-month low), 3.0 cents in Charlottetown (to a three-month low), 2.6 cents in Calgary, 2.3 cents in Edmonton, 2.2 cents in Vancouver, 1.1 cents in Toronto (to a three-month low), 1.0 cents in Regina, and 0.8 cents in Montreal (to a two-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined by 1.7 cents from a 17-month high to 99.7 cents.

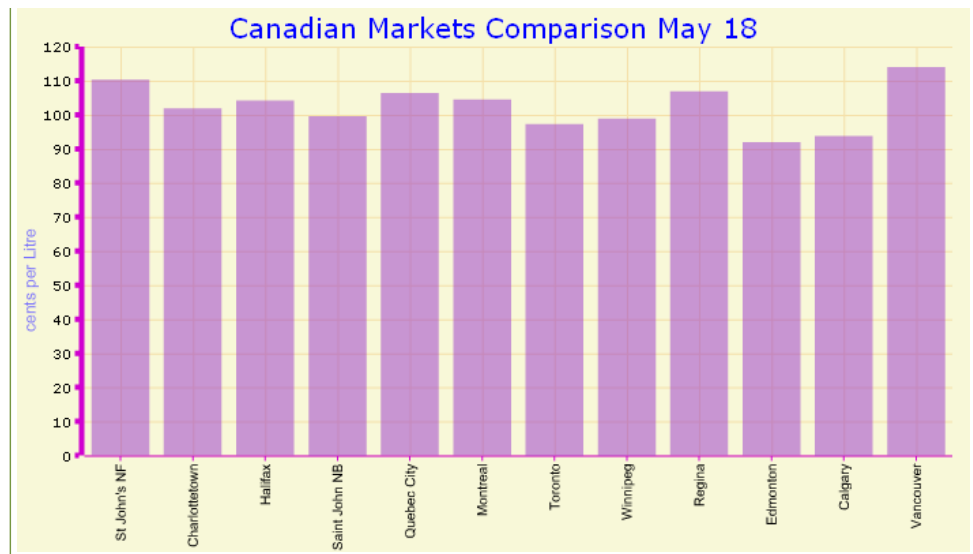

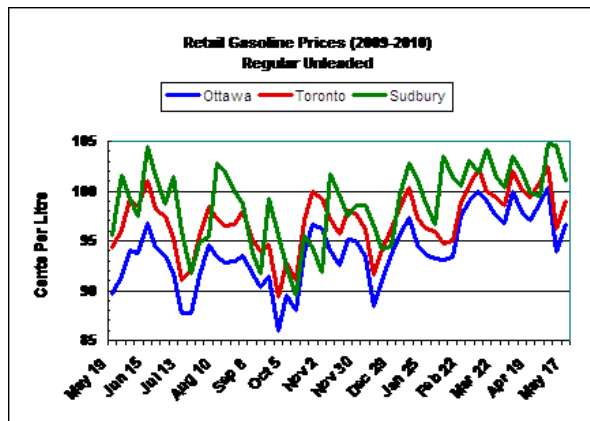
