Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending June 7, 2010.

Lower wholesale prices and price wars in some markets caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to decline by 2.1 cents to 94.5 cents a litre, a six-month low.

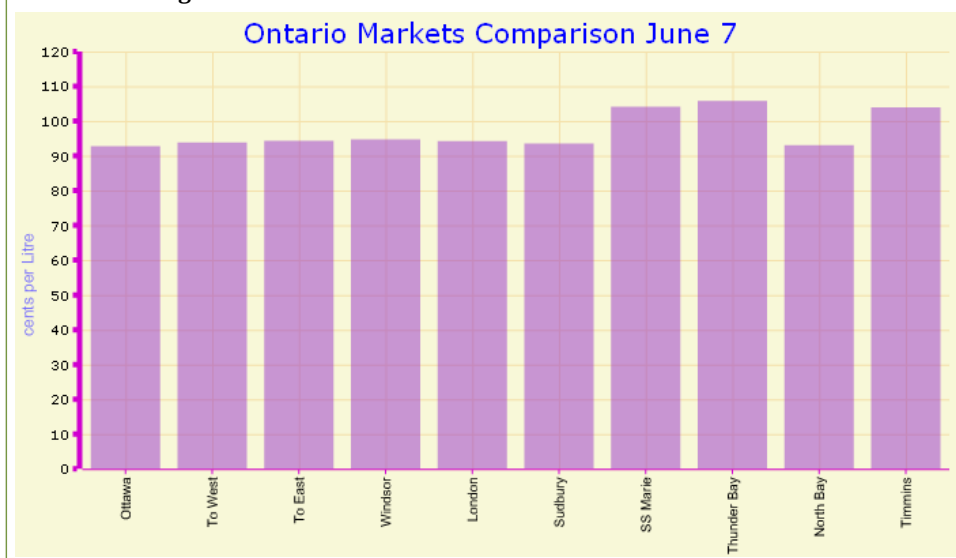
Prices fell by 3.0 cents in Timmins (to a five-month low), 2.6 cents in Toronto (to a six-month low), 2.5 cents in both London (to a six-month low) and North Bay (to an eight-month low), 2.3 cents in Sudbury (to a seven-month low), 2.0 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to a two-month low), 1.6 cents in Ottawa (to a six-month low), and 1.1 cents in Thunder Bay (to a two-month low). Prices rose by 3.7 cents in Windsor. Ottawa ended Windsor's 17-week run as the lowest-priced market. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the fourth straight week, by 0.7 cents to 93.5 cents, a five-month low.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after declining four straight weeks, increased by 0.6 cents from a four-month low to 99.6 cents. Prices rose by 3.3 cents in Montreal (from a two-month low), 2.5 cents in Vancouver (from a two-month low), 1.8 cents in Halifax (from a five-month low), 1.5 cents in Saint John (from a five-month low), 1.4 cents in St. John's (from a seven-month low), and 0.4 cents in Calgary (from a four-month low). Prices fell by 1.3 cents in Toronto (to a six-month low), 1.0 cents in Quebec City (to a five-month low), and less than a cent in Edmonton (to a four-month low), Charlottetown, and Winnipeg (to a three-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the fourth straight week, by 0.5 to 96.1 cents, a five-month low.

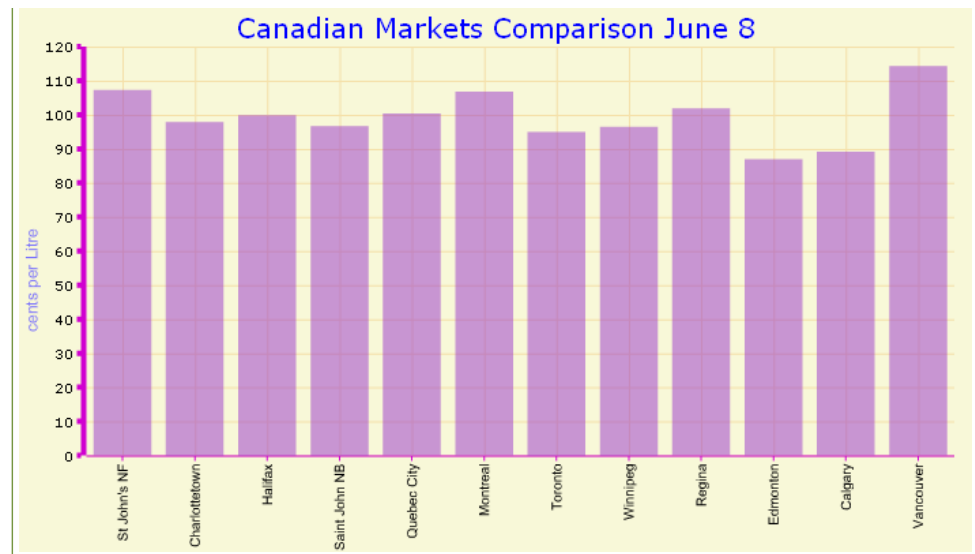

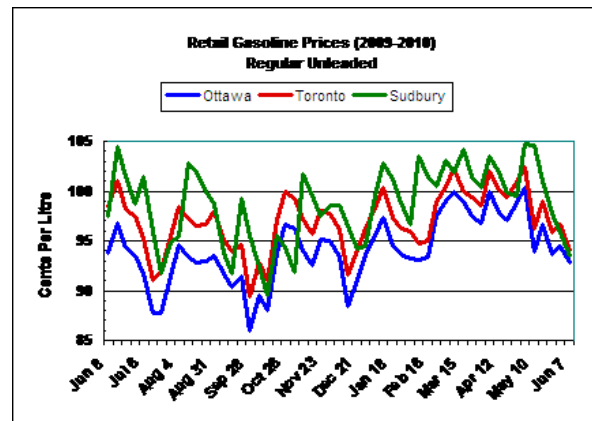
