Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending June 14, 2010.

Despite lower wholesale prices, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline increased slightly from a six-month low, by 0.7 cents to 95.2 cents a litre.

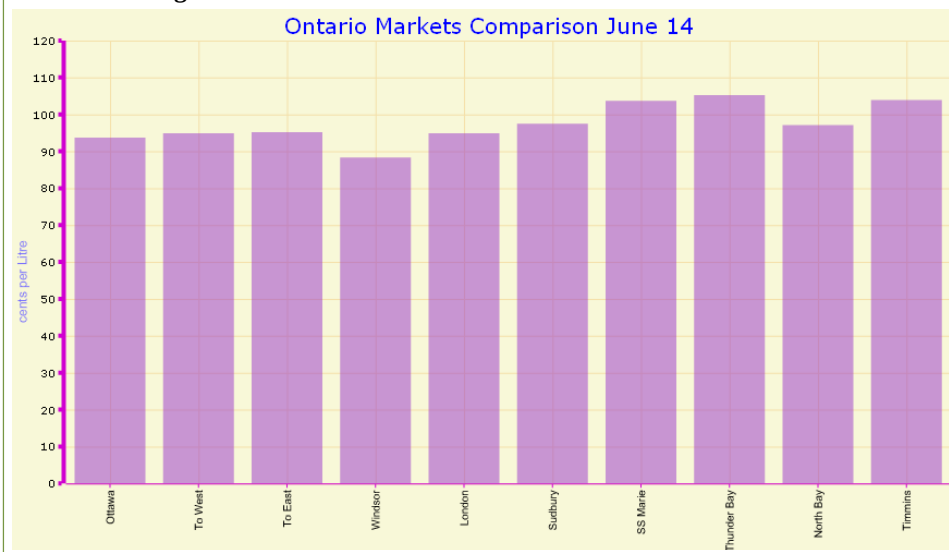
Prices rose by 4.0 cents in both Sudbury (from a seven-month low) and North Bay (from an eight-month low), 1.0 cents in Toronto (from a six-month low), and less than a cent in Ottawa (from a six-month low) and London (from a six-month low). Prices fell by 6.4 cents in Windsor and less than a cent in Thunder Bay (to a two-month low) and Sault Ste. Marie (to a two-month low). The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened from 5.9 cents to 6.9 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after declining four straight weeks, increased by 0.4 cents from a five-month low to 93.9 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 0.6 cents to 99.0 cents. Prices fell by 2.1 cents in Montreal, 1.7 cents in Winnipeg (to a five-month low), 1.3 cents in Vancouver, 1.2 cents in Quebec City (to an eight-month low), and less than a cent in Calgary (to a four-month low), Regina (to a three-month low), and Edmonton (to a six-month low). Prices rose by less than a cent in Halifax, Toronto (from a six-month low), and St. John's. The Canadian average retail diesel price, after declining four straight weeks, increased by 0.1 cents from a five-month low to 96.2 cents.

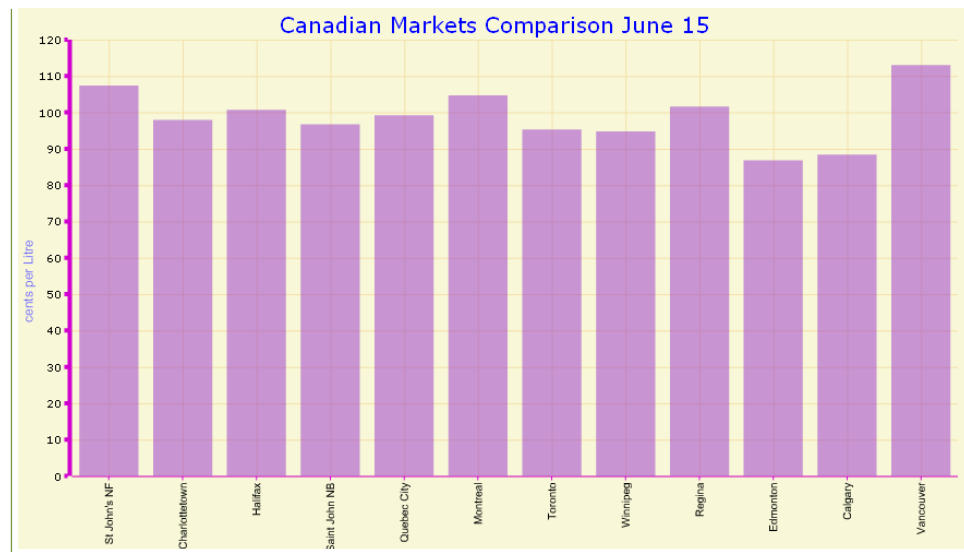

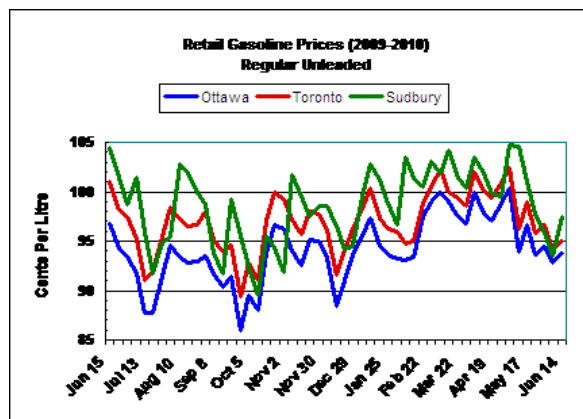
