Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending July 19, 2010.

After rising five straight weeks, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 0.4 cents from a 21-month high to 102.6 cents a litre, reflecting lower wholesale prices.

Prices fell by 2.5 cents in Windsor, 2.4 cents in both Sudbury and North Bay, 1.3 cents in Thunder Bay, and less than a cent in Toronto East (from a 21-month high), Sault Ste. Marie, and London (from a 21-month high). Prices rose by less than a cent in Toronto West and Ottawa (both to a 21-month high). Windsor had the lowest average price for the sixth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed for the second straight week, from 4.6 cents to 3.3 cents, a three-month low. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the second straight week, by 0.1 cents to 99.1 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 0.5 cents to 102.9 cents, a two-month high. Prices rose by 1.5 cents in both St. John's and Saint John, 1.4 cents in Halifax, 1.3 cents in Toronto (to a three-month high), 1.1 cents in Vancouver (to a 21-month high), and 0.1 cents in Regina. Prices fell by 1.2 cents in Charlottetown, 1.1 cents in Montreal, 1.0 cents in Quebec City, and less than a cent in Edmonton and Calgary. The Canadian average retail diesel price declined for the second straight week, by 0.4 cents to 97.2 cents.

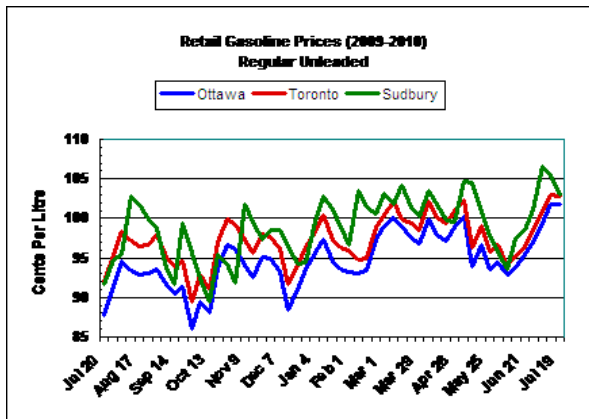
