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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending August 3, 2010.

The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 0.4 cents from a 22-month high to 103.4 cents a litre, reflecting lower wholesale prices and discounting in some markets.

Prices fell by 2.7 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (from a 21-month high), 2.5 cents in North Bay (from a 21-month high), 2.2 cents in both Windsor and Sudbury (the latter from a 21-month high), and less than a cent in London (from a 22-month high), Ottawa (from a 22-month high), Thunder Bay, and Toronto (from a 22-month high). Prices rose by 2.4 cents in Timmins (to a 22-month high). Windsor had the lowest average price for the eighth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed from 5.2 cents to 4.1 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined by 0.2 cents to 99.2 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after increasing two straight weeks, declined by 1.2 cents from a three-month high to 103.1 cents. Prices fell by 9.7 cents in Montreal (to a seven-month low) and 0.2 cents in Vancouver (from a 22-month high). Prices rose by 6.5 cents from a seven-month low in Edmonton (to a three-month high), 4.4 cents in Calgary (to a three-month high), 1.2 cents in Charlottetown, 1.1 cents in Saint John, 1.0 cents in St. John's, and 0.5 cents in Toronto (to a 22-month high). The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the second straight week, by 0.3 cents to 97.6 cents.

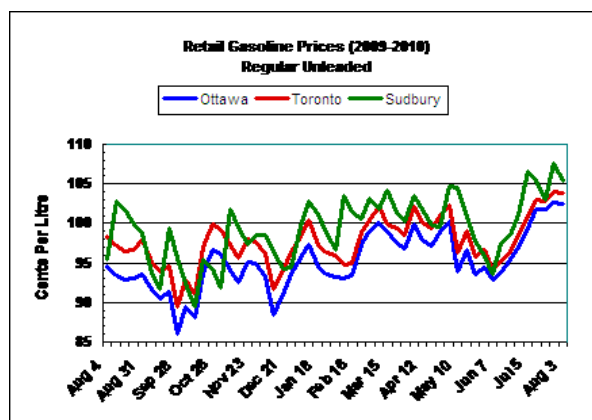
