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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending August 16, 2010.

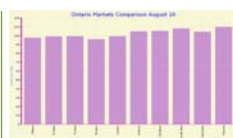
The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 3.8 cents to 99.6 cents a litre, a two-month low, reflecting lower world crude oil and North American wholesale prices.

Prices fell by 4.1 cents in Ottawa and Toronto (both to a two-month low), 4.0 cents in London (to a two-month low), 3.5 cents in Windsor, 3.1 cents in both North Bay and Timmins, 3.0 cents in Sudbury (from a 22-month high), and 0.8 cents in Thunder Bay. Windsor had the lowest average price for the sixth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened for the second straight week, from 5.4 cents to 7.5 cents, a three-month high. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined by 0.8 cents from a 21-month high to 99.1 cents.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 2.7 cents to 101.6 cents, a two-month low. Prices fell by 4.8 cents in Toronto (to a two-month low), 3.5 cents in Montreal, 2.8 cents in Halifax (from a three-month high), 2.5 cents in Charlottetown (to a three-month low), 2.0 cents in Quebec City (from a three-month high), and less than a cent in Saint John (from a three-month high), St. John's (from a three-month high), Calgary (from a three-month high), and Vancouver. Prices rose by 2.0 cents in Winnipeg (to a three-month high). The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the fourth straight week, by 1.0 cents to 99.7 cents, a three-month high.

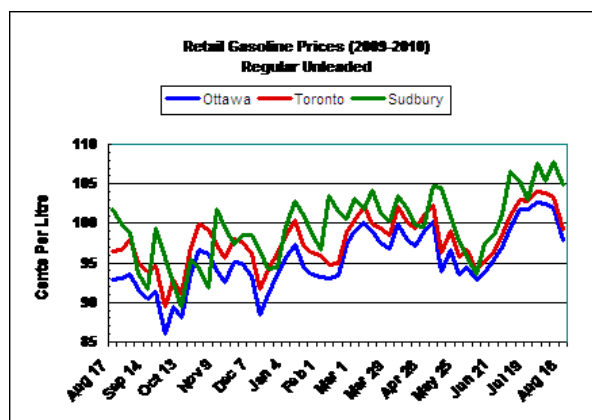
